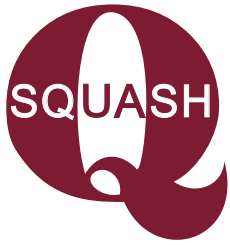

AFFILIATION

A message from Q Squash President - Ros Preston

Following the AGM of Squash Australia in November and the recent Q Squash Board meeting the following affiliation categories have been set for 2017.

- 1. Full Registration \$66.00 per annum - Q Squash fee payable up front.** This covers you for all organised squash competitions and tournaments and includes Player Accident Insurance and access to Matrix. Some regions may charge an additional fee to this so you need to talk to your regional committee or your centre operator for the actual price payable in your region.
- 2. Seasonal Registration \$40.00 - Q Squash fee payable up front at beginning of each season - 2 seasons per year.** This covers you for all organised squash competitions and tournaments and includes Player Accident Insurance and access to Matrix.
- 3. Social Registration \$33.00 - Q Squash fee payable up front.** This covers social hire players with Player Accident Insurance.
- 4. Affiliate Registration \$10.00 per annum.** Typically for parents of players or persons wanting to be a friend of "Squash".

Affiliations fall due on 1st January and expire on 31st December of each year for full playing/paying players ... remember if your season goes over into the new year you will need to renew to remain covered for player accident insurance.

Being affiliated to your State and National bodies helps both organisations to obtain funding from Government. Funding is heavily based on the numbers of registered players a sport has. The more players we have registered the more money we should be able to access to grow the grassroots and HP levels of our wonderful sport.

All players affiliating have access to the Q Squash Newsletter and also the Squash Australia members portal where you can obtain great discounts off everyday purchases.

By being an affiliated player in Queensland you are helping to fund the Q Open, Mackay Open, Cairns International, Sandgate Women's Open, Brisbane Open, Scottvale Park Open, Gladstone Open and Moura Open throughout 2017. As well as these events Q Squash is able to help support our Junior Sharks to attend both the Australian Junior Championships and the Australian Junior Open.

Without the support of our players we would not be able to do any of these things. Please be proactive in spreading the word to help us grow our numbers in 2017.

169 players participated in the **2017 Australian Junior Open** in Darwin in January. 40 Queenslanders made the journey. 18 players went from Brisbane, 2 from Central, 13 from Northern and 7 from Southern.

Mackay's **Hayley Hankinson** won the U15 Girls Championship. She beat fellow Queenslander Katie Davies 4-11, 12-10, 4-11, 11-9, 11-7 in the final.

#7S Josh Penfold upset fellow Queenslander and #1S Wes Dyer to reach the semi finals of the Boys U15 17-15, 9-11, 11-7, 11-7 (35m).

Unfortunately, Josh was no match for the eventual champion Leo Fatialofa NZ. "The Fat" won 11-6, 11-4, 12-10 (22m).

Josh then pushed #2S Remi Young from WA all the way in the 3/4 Playoff losing in five 6-11, 4-11, 11-8, 11-5, 6-11.

#8S Lachlan Coxsedg lost his Quarter Final match up with #1S Scott Galloway 3-11, 11-9, 5-11, 5-11. That put him in the Playoffs for 5-8.

Lachlan was too good for #7S Ryan Marshall from NSW 12-10, 12-10, 11-7 (33m) before posting a great win over Nick Calvert (QLD) 11-9, 11-1, 12-10 to take 5th place.

Caleb Johnson knocked out two seeds on his way to finishing 4th in the Bu19 event. Unseeded Caleb beat #6S Sam Heydon from SA 11-4, 11-3, 11-9 and then #3S

Caleb got off to a flying start winning the first 11-4 but van der Kreek wore him down over the next three games 11-5, 11-5, 11-5 (35m).

In the playoff for 3rd Caleb had to take on the #1S Scott Galloway from NZ. Caleb performed extremely well to go down narrowly in three 15-17, 9-11, 10-12 (28m).

Shona Coxsedg and Lauren Stieler finished in Top 10 positions.

In the Playoff for 5-8, Shona lost a close battle with Cairns's Kiara Stubley 7-11, 11-9, 11-8, 1-11, 8-11 (29m). Disappointingly the final Playoff for 7-8 was not played.

Lauren Stieler is another promising youngster improving all the time. Her gutsy win 11-3 in the 5th at the AJO in Darwin against Isabella Diver from WA was full of merit and a positive sign for the future.
