The first is the **RedStar** Awards and they run for the entire year and include qualifiers, State and National individual results.

This year we also introduced a reward system whereby the player's results drive the points.

The second set of Awards have been around for a very long time and are decided on by the parents at each of the qualifiers.

The awarding of **RedStar** Points also caused a little concern when it was decided to combine the U9, U11 and U13 Boys in Townsville.

As we have always recognised the lower age groups we will continue to do so by awarding the highest finish with the maximum points providing there are at least 2 players in that age group.

Mackay's Hayley Hankinson has just won the Q Squash Award for the Queensland Junior Female Player of the Year. The Award ceremony was held in conjunction with the Squash Australia Annual Awards in Townsville.

That was a fantastic achievement for the current U15 Girls Australian Junior Open and Junior Closed Champion. Her coach Kay Barclay, who passed away in early February, would have been extremely proud of Hayley's achievement.

AUSTRALIAN CLOSED

The Townsville Tenpin and Fun Centre has just hosted the 2017 Australian Closed Championships.

The Men's Open event was a PSA National Closed Satellite and it attracted a solid field of 16 players. #1 seed **Zac Alexander** continued his dominance of the domestic circuit with a powerhouse performance against #2S Rhys Dowling winning 11-7, 11-2, 11-1.

The Women's Open attracted 14 competitors and was taken out in clinical fashion by **Tamika Saxby**. Saxby won 5 PSA titles on the domestic circuit last year and looks set to have another big year with a strong 3-0 win over Lisa Camilleri.

Northern Region players dominated the 6 Graded Finals winning 5. Wests Squash Club players secured two titles, Cairns also won two titles with Dalrymple winning one when Elliot Geddes took out the Men's A Grade Championships from a field of 32 players. 77 competitors participated in the graded section of the Australian Closed.



2017 REDSTAR AWARDS





In an effort to recognise more NR juniors we have introduced a new system of performance recognition. From now on **every finalist will be recognised**. Each winner will be listed in the Achievement category and every finalist (runner up) will be listed in the Encouragement category.

Once a player has won an event they will be elevated and listed in the Achievement category even if they finish runner up in other events. If players are equal they will be listed in alphabetical order.

Players receive 2 points for winning a qualifier, 4 points for winning a State title and 6 points for winning a National title (AJO & AJC). Players will receive 1 point for finishing runner up in a qualifier, 2 points for runner up in a State final and 3 points for runner up in a National final.

Even though the Ingham qualifier was played in October 2016 it is still a 2017 qualifier so the results from that event will contribute to the **2017 NR Player of the Year Award.** A 2018 qualifier played in 2017 will not be included.

The player who accumulates the most points will be declared the Player of the Year. There will be joint winners if 2 players finish on the same number of points. The aim of the points system is to automate the selection and player results determine the outcome. The system is also designed to encourage players to support all events in their quest to accumulate points.

To be awarded points there must be at least two players competing in an age group.

If an event is combined eg U17 and U19 Combined then it will be analysed to ensure points are allocated to both U17 and U19. A direct match up of the best two players in an age group will determine the winner of that age group. Otherwise the highest finishing position in an age group will receive the maximum points.

A player can only enter up to 2 events so they can only be rewarded with 2 results. An U9 player who might win a combined event eg U9, U11 and U13 Combined can only be rewarded for the U13 victory and their own age group U9. If they were the only player in U9 they will earn points for both U13 and U11.
