WA OPEN



The 76th WA Open Squash Championships were held in Perth from 26-28th May at **The Club Perth** (formerly Terrace Squash). The event was sponsored by WA Squash, Blade and The Club Perth.

Players from Singapore, Hong Kong, interstate and regional WA competed with local players making up a strong field of 98 players for the WA Open.

Mike Corren won his 6th Open title, closing in on the record 9 Dean Williams won. Corren defeated Dave Ilich in a convincing display of court craft and control: 11/2, 11/3, 11/4. Seeded No 1 and 2 respectively, both men won their semi-finals 3 games to nil.

In the women's event Singaporean, **Joannah Yue-Hitch** and local Sue Hillier caused upsets by

defeating the No 1 and

2 seeds in the semi-final. In a closely contested final Yue proved too strong for Hillier defeating her 11/7, 10/12, 11/8, 11/9.

The Men's masters was a tough draw. Many of them played a second division, perhaps not the best decision by those who had to pull out.

The Ladies had 4 divisions with two juniors taking out a title. It was great to see some new players and the return of some of our older competitors.

The Men's had 5 divisions which were all closely contested. Again two juniors won an event. There was almost a chance father/son match, but luckily for the son (haha) it didn't work out.

A special thanks goes to **Don Huffer** for his tireless work behind the scene and running the tournament all weekend.

After a very successful 2016 and the recent 2017 World Masters Games WA Players Sue Hillier, Anne Richards and Sue Volzke have been selected to represent Australia in the 2017 Tran Tasman team.

The Trans Tasman Test Series will be held in Ballarat in September 2017. The first test is scheduled for 1/9, the second for the 2/9 with the final test for the 9/9. The final test is set to follow the Australian Masters Individual Championships.

The ladies are excited about the prospect of representing Australia again. Hillier said "Playing against the kiwis is such great fun. The matches are always competitive and hard fought. The teams get on well, have great respect for one another and enjoy the social aspect of the game"



FACILITIES

VIC PARK UPGRADE

After a period of consultation between the local council and the club, Vic Park Squash Club (VPSC) saw major renovations take place to two of the four courts they use at the Leisurelife Centre in East Victoria Park.

VPSC have a large and thriving club, with ten teams playing in-house Pennant on a Monday, teams playing in all the pennant nights, and a busy Saturday morning social hit that can see more than twenty turn up.

On top of this, VPSC are constantly bringing through top juniors, coached by World Champion, Sue Hillier.

Trying to coordinate the refurbishments of the courts to ensure minimal disruption was one of the priorities for the club, and they were fortunate that the Town of Victoria Park selected **CourtTech** Australia as the preferred supplier.

CourtTech have extensive experience building new courts and refurbishing older ones, and have carried out other projects in WA, including six new courts in Kalgoorlie.



With this experience and background, **CourtTech** had an ambitious one week schedule to replace the walls, floors, tin and lights in two courts. The only thing to remain was the glass backs and door, which were in good order.

Work commenced on Monday 6th February, and **CourtTech** delivered on schedule, with both courts being used the following Monday for club night. Great to see squash continuing to thrive in Victoria Park.


