# PRESIDENT'S COURT By Dean Morzone

My heartiest congratulations to our Northern Region winners and all players for their strong performance in the QJC. Our players personified good sportsmanship, team spirit and camaraderie throughout the championships. It was also fitting that the trophies were presented by the great Geoff Hunt.

Further, my thanks to our committee (past and present), our team manager/coach (Alec), coaches (Janelle, Gill & Lucas), our wonderful cooks & dorm parents. Our successful campaign is a credit to each of you extraordinary people.

I want to work with Q Squash to improve the QJC where ever possible. Please communicate any concerns, suggested solutions and other matters to Alec MacDonald for his report. I will ensure they are well communicated to the Q Squash president.

The QJC provided a terrific opportunity for all to contribute to our meeting. I'm thrilled to share some forward thinking and exciting resolutions about our future junior tournaments:

- 1. Northern Region will transition to modernise our tournament software over the next 12 months to better integrate with Q Squash (subject our tournament organisers' confidence in the efficiency of SportyHQ).
- There are some glitches in SportyHQ (eg. ranking) that the developers must iron out. But I believe it has many advantages for example:
- It is free to affiliates;
- electronic scoring via smart phone for real time updates on score board and internet:
- It will add a fun factor for our electronic savvy player generation;
- the system will integrate with Q Squash; and
- player history can be readily accessed by selectors.
- 2. Our Northern Region tournaments will have some new features:

- a) Two tiers an aged championship, alongside a novice graded competition.
   This will encourage and inspire new players to the sport and tournaments;
- b) Doubles team nominations & matches (starting in Ingham with Friday evening games);
- c) Coaching clinics 30 to 45 minutes at the end of a day. These may include interactive tasks about advanced stroke correction, fitness, stretching, rules and refereeing.

We will review the capacity of our tournament centres to ensure they can run all these exciting additions.

- 3. A Sponsorship and Fundraising Sub-Committee will be established comprising one or more representatives of each centre. The committee will be tasked to:
  - a) Explore additional corporate/business sponsorship, run "big" raffles, and make government grant applications.
  - b) Write funding grants, and inform players and centres of other grants.
  - c) Facilitate sponsorship for tournaments, uniforms, players and traveling coaches:
  - d) Establish a fund so we may better support clubs, coaches, and players eg. Recording equipment (like GoPro), ball machines, travel subsidies, and player bursaries, etc.


In addition, we may see a return to valuable prizes in tournaments whether in cash or kind (like the good old days).

The committee also invites nominations for an honorary regional coaching coordinator. The position will train and develop regional and club coaches, liaise with Q Squash & Lisa Camilleri, introduce coaching camps and co-ordinate tournament sessions. Please give me any names of nominees you think might have these skills.

Finally, I wish our players all the very best for Sharks selection, and preparation for the AJC. You have well earned our congratulations and admiration.

### **2017 REDSTAR AWARDS**



In an effort to recognise more NR juniors we have introduced a new system of performance recognition. From now on **every finalist will be recognised**. Each winner will be listed in the Achievement category and every finalist (runner up) will be listed in the Encouragement category.

Once a player has won an event they will be elevated and listed in the Achievement category even if they finish runner up in other events. If players are equal they will be listed in alphabetical order.

Players receive 2 points for winning a qualifier, 4 points for winning a State title and 6 points for winning a National title (AJO & AJC). Players will receive 1 point for finishing runner up in a qualifier, 2 points for runner up in a State final and 3 points for runner up in a National final.

Even though the Ingham qualifier was played in October 2016 it is still a 2017 qualifier so the results from that event will contribute to the **2017 NR Player of the Year Award.** A 2018 qualifier played in 2017 will not be included.

The player who accumulates the most points will be declared the Player of the Year. There will be joint winners if 2 players finish on the same number of points. The aim of the points system is to automate the selection and player results determine the outcome. The system is also designed to encourage players to support all events in their quest to accumulate points.

To be awarded points there must be at least two players competing in an age group.

If an event is combined eg U17 and U19 Combined then it will be analysed to ensure

points are allocated to both U17 and U19. A direct match up of the best two players in an age group will determine the winner of that age group. Otherwise the highest finishing position in an age group will receive the maximum points.

A player can only enter up to 2 events so they can only be rewarded with 2 results. An U9 player who might win a combined event eg U9, U11 and U13 Combined can only be rewarded for the U13 victory and their own age group U9. If they were the only player in U9 they will earn points for both U13 and U11.



- 1 Games may be scheduled for Friday evening for available players.
- 2 Otherwise players are expected to be available between 8:30 am and 5 pm on Saturday and Sunday except with prior approval.
- 3 Doubles teams will be determined to maximise experience in that format.
- 4 The Graded draw is intended for new or less experienced players who wish to compete in a separate draw with players of similar ability and proficiency regardless of age. The players will be graded based on ability by tournament organisers.
- 5 Graded events are not eligible for rankings or Redbacks team selection.
- 6 All grading will be made relative to Q Squash guidelines and the tournament committee reserves the right to regrade any player.
- 7 Best of 5 Games to 11 PARS Tie break at 10 all.

To win a game you must win it by 2 points

- 8 XX Yellow Dot balls will be used.
- 9 The wearing of Protective Eyewear is **COMPULSORY** at this tournament.
- 10 Players are to be present and checked in with Tournament Control 30 MINUTES before the scheduled time of their match.
- 11 All Players are to mark and referee the next match at the completion of their own match.
- 12 All players MUST BE Financial members of Q Squash and under their respective age group as at **15 October 2017.**
- 13 Entry fees are due and payable once the draw has been completed. No refunds will be made.
- 14 Photos may be taken during the championship for use by media outlets, the Northern Region website and REDBACKS Newsletter.
- 15 All players must abide by the Q Squash JUNIOR PLAYER BEHAVIOUR Policy Version 2 Effective 1/1/09, which can be read on the Q Squash website.
