LARKIN WINS BENDIGO INTERNATIONAL

#1 seed **Josh Larkin** dropped just 2 games on route to the final of the **Bendigo International** where he met unseeded Ryunosuke Tsukue from Japan.

Tsukue ranked #498 in the World surprised his more fancied opponents to reach his first ever PSA final. The 20 year old reached the quarter finals of the 2016 World Junior Championships and won the Hong Kong Junior U19 title in 2016.

Tsukue won all his matches leading up to the final in straight beating the #7, #3 and #8 seeds in the process. However, his purple patch of form came to an abrupt end when he met Larkin in the final. The match hardened Aussie destroyed Tsukue in 28 minutes 11-2, 11-7, 11-4.

It was PSA title number 2 for Larkin in 2017 and his 5th career title.

HO TZE-LOK CAUSES UPSET IN BENDIGO

#2 seed **Ho Tze-Lok** caused an upset when she beat her more fancied opponent in the “Hong Kong final” of the **Bendigo International**.

#43 in World rankings, Ho Tze-Lok beat #1 seed and World #34 Liu Tsz-Ling in four in 37 minutes. Ho Tze-Lok began strongly winning the first 11-5 but Liu Tsz-Ling bounced back just as impressively winning the second 11-4.

Ho Tze-Lok went into overdrive in the 3rd winning 11-2 before the two knuckled down to a nail biting tussle in the 4th with Ho Tze-Lok prevailing 12-10. It was her 3rd PSA title for 2017 and her second on Aussie soil having won the Sandgate Open in March.

The 21 year old had a marathon semi final clash with Aussie Samantha Foyle sneaking home 11-7 in the fifth. The match went for 50 minutes with many turning points.

TWO IN A ROW FOR LARKIN

In the final of the **Shepparton International**, #1 seed **Josh Larkin** displayed true grit and determination over 79 minutes to outlast #5 seed Bernat Jaume from Spain.

Larkin, ranked #77 in the World was expected to be too strong in the final for the 21 year old W#159 given he beat him in the semi final of the Bendigo International but that wasn't the case.

Jaume won the first and 3rd games to take a commanding 2 games to 1 lead before Larkin staged a sustained and impressive comeback to win 12-10 in the 5th.

Larkin also recorded a solid victory over fellow Aussie Rhys Dowling in the semi final.

It was Larkin's third PSA title for the year and his 6th career title.
