The **Trans Tasman Test Series** between Australia and New Zealand was played immediately prior (first 2 tests) and straight after the Individual Championships. Australia dominated the series winning all 3 tests.



There were 261 (Queensland 69, Victoria 66 and NSW 60) participants in the Individual and 339 (NSW 97, Victoria 74 and Queensland 54) in the teams event.
