ALEXANDER WINS WHITE OAK

Queenslander **Zac Alexander** surprised a number of people with a win in the PSA M10 event held at Club at White Oaks, Niagara-On-The-Lake, Ontario, Canada.

Seeded #8 and making his return to the professional circuit after the World Doubles Championship in August, Alexander served notice to the rest of the field when he knocked out Canada's highest ranked player Nick Sachvie in straight in the quarter finals.

He then faced Canada's next best player Shawn Delierre in the semis and despite going to four was too strong for the former W#35. Alexander himself has reached a career high #38 so it was a good match up which lasted 72 minutes before the younger man triumphed.

Alexander then stepped it up a gear destroying Jamaican Christopher Binnie in the 45 minute final 3-0 to claim his 27th Tour Title.
