The QMSA is looking forward to the biggest event on the QMSA tournament calendar, namely our State Titles to be held at the Acacia Ridge squash courts on the 4th, 5th and 6th of May.

We have 122 entrants for this event, which is our largest State Titles for some years. We will be following the scoring format that will used later in the year at the Australian Masters Championships in Tasmania in September. That is, we are moving to PAR 15 for all age groups at this tournament.

We will commence competition on the Friday night, then continuing Saturday and Sunday, with a Presentation and BBQ on the Sunday evening. A Dinner Dance will be held on the Saturday night at the Calamvale Hotel, where we will have Sarah Fitz-Gerald as our Guest Speaker.

Sarah is well known to most squash enthusiasts, as she not only won 5 open World titles and a Commonwealth Games Gold Medal in her heyday, but has also won 2 Masters World Titles as well.

Working alongside Sarah will be Adrian Williams (fresh from his hosting stint at the Commonwealth Games) and Eric Summons (well known comedian, magician and QMSA member).

We will also be presenting our latest Life Membership to a very deserving recipient at the Dinner Dance.

The last QMSA tournament was held at Stafford in March with a field of 80 entries. This tournament was also our annual Presidents vs Patron event, and I'm proud to say that the President's team prevailed (again).

A least Murray Gaydon (our Patron) had a chance to hold the trophy for a short period at the presentation before I whisked it away back to its (now permanent?) resting place in my display case.

Congratulations must go to the Gold medal winning Mixed doubles and Men's doubles teams, and bronze medal winners in the Women's doubles at the Commonwealth games.

Surely David Palmer, after competing in 6 Commonwealth Games and winning 3 gold, 2 silver and 4 bronze medals,

must be considered one of Australia's greatest Commonwealth Games sportsman.

After the State Titles our next tournament will be at Alexandra Hills courts on the 26th and 27th May.

QMSA will then venture north of Brisbane to Gympie for our next tournament on the 15th, 16th and 17th June at the newly built Victory Courts.

There will be a doubles event on the Friday, followed by a singles event on the Saturday and Sunday. Numbers for this event will be limited so make sure to get your entry in early.

These courts are owned and operated by Matt Robinson (who, by the way will also be operating his coffee cart at the State Titles). Please support Matt by consuming copious amounts of coffee at the State Titles and entering his tournament later in June.


