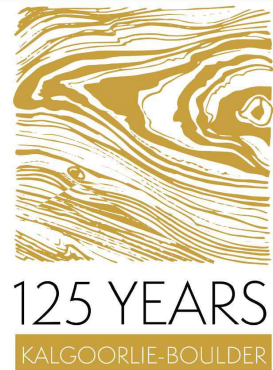

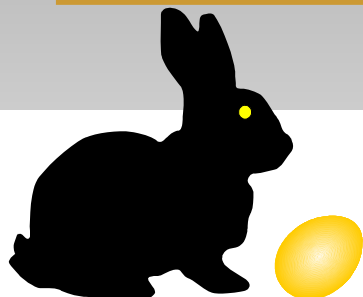

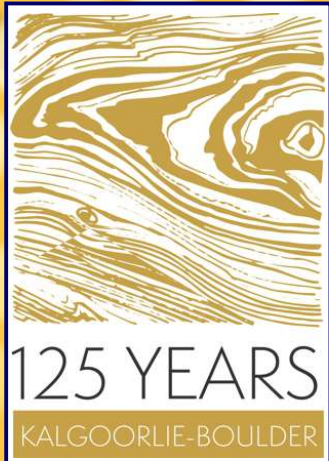

We are working to improve our facilities and encourage more people to play squash. We would like to grow our club to at least 200 members by 2020.

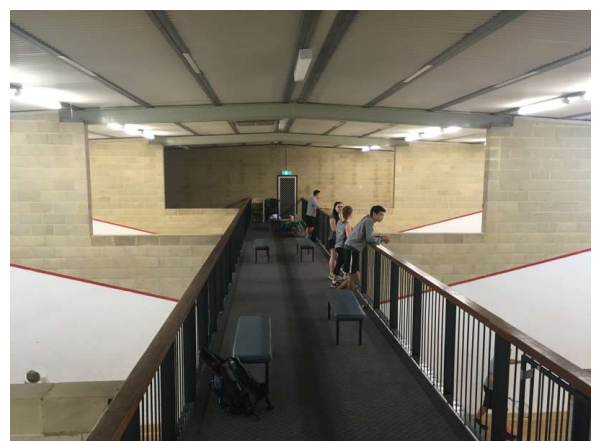
