

The objectives are to remove uncertainty, undue delay, subjective assessments, divergent opinions and disagreement from the ranking process. The policy is expected to be applied uniformly throughout Queensland, and regional selectors will update their own and State rankings after qualifiers. It will also provide certainty and transparency - Players ought know how they're ranked.

I have asked the committee and our regional selectors to study, consider and rigorously test the draft policy, talk to our players and parents, and write to me with any concerns by 1 June 2018. I will then collate and summarise the information into a regional position and send it (including your submissions) to Q Squash by 3 June 2018.

NQ Games

Players from 52 attended the Opening Ceremony of the Games on Friday night getting into the "Spirit of Participation" as the cauldron was lit and the Athlete's Oath read out to all.

There were 7 Divisions for players to compete in, ranging from Open to Novices along with Ladies Masters and Mens Masters. There were a few hardy (or crazy) individuals who thought they were still young and fit, who decided to nominate for two divisions on the weekend. They survived, but were a lot slower and less resilient by Sunday morning.

Our 7 Novice players (3 of them had never played a tournament before) had great matches playing with Ben's "modified 52 Novice" rules. The crowd got into the spirit of the games too with loud cheering and encouragement for both players on the court. The adults were also embracing the atmosphere with a lot of laughter coming from the courts during the day. Number 1 seed, Ben Courtice, went down in a tight match to BJ MacDonald. Although it could be argued that Ben had a lot on his mind with the 50th celebrations to be held later on in the day, you cannot take the win from BJ who played a well-structured match to emerge the victor. This match set the tone for the rest of the Open matches played over the weekend, with quality squash being played by all our competitors.

Saturday afternoon saw the return of many old faces to the courts to celebrate the Courtice family's 50 years at the courts. Stories of past victories and epic battles were told with a hint of nostalgia and the feeling of comradery. It is a credit to the Courtice family for their dedication in maintaining their family's love of the game of Squash.

All too soon, it was Sunday morning and the few who were playing two divisions were giving serious consideration as to why on earth they nominated for two divisions. There were a few groans as the muscles they forgot they had reminded players that they weren't that young anymore. Realising that they weren't going to get any sympathy from anyone, these players staggered on court hoping their muscles would warm up sooner rather than later.

Teagan Ollett should be awarded the Iron Woman medal for the weekend. She also played in the Netball tournament for the weekend and managed to "walk" away with the Gold for the B Grade, defeating Lindsay Hains in the finals.

Janelle Fox had a clean sweep in the Ladies Masters division, coming away with a Gold medallion and also winning Bronze in the A Grade. The Open division final was a clash of our two most talented juniors in Mackay, Wes Dyer and BJ MacDonald. One of the Sporting Ambassadors for the NQ Games, Renae Kunst, who has recently retired as the Australian Womens Rugby League Captain, arrived in time to see the battle between Wes and BJ. It was great to have her spend time at 52 and be able to present our players with their medallions. Some of our Novices are still a bit star-struck after meeting her.

Thank you also must go to the NQ Games for allowing Squash 52 to compete in the 2018 NQ Games. Their organisational skills were outstanding and their support was greatly appreciated. The baton has now been passed onto Townsville with the next Games to be held in 2020, we are hoping that Squash will again be one of the many sports to be played.

Finally, thank you to Dan Wagner and the Courtice's, for their help throughout the weekend and in the lead up to the weekend. We look forward to seeing everyone at the 52 Open to be held 3-4 November.





2018 REDSTAR AWARDS



In an effort to recognise more NR juniors we have revised our system of performance recognition. From now on every placegetter (1-2-3) will be recognised. Each winner of an aged event will be listed in the Achievement category and every player who finishes second or third will be listed in the Encouragement category.

Once a player has won an event they will be elevated and listed in the Achievement category even if they finish runner up or third in other events. If players are equal they will be listed in alphabetical order.

Players receive 3 points for winning a qualifier, 6 points for winning a Queensland State title and 9 points for winning a National title (AJO & AJC). Players will receive 2 points for finishing runner up in a qualifier, 4 points for runner up in a State final and 6 points for runner up in a National final. Players will receive 1 point for finishing third in a qualifier, 2 points for third in a State final and 3 points for third in a National event. U19 Players will also receive 1 bonus point for each result because they cannot enter 2 events.

Even though the Ingham qualifier was played in October 2017 it is still a 2018 qualifier so the results from that event will contribute to the **2018 NR Player of the Year Award.** A 2019 qualifier played in 2018 will not be included.

The player who accumulates the most points will be declared the Player of the Year. There will be joint winners if 2 players finish on the same number of points. The aim of the points system is to automate the selection and player results determine the outcome. The system is also designed to encourage players to support all events in their quest to accumulate points.

If an event is combined eg U17 and U19 Combined then it will be analysed to ensure points are allocated to both U17 and U19. A direct match up of the best two players in an age group will determine the winner of that age group. Otherwise the highest finishing position in an age group will receive the maximum points. **To be awarded points there must be at least two players competing in an age group.**

A player can only enter up to 2 events so they can only be rewarded with 2 results. An U9 player who might win a combined event eg **U9**, **U11 and U13 Combined** can only be rewarded for the U13 victory and their own age group U9 providing there are two U9 players competing. If there is only one player in U9 they will earn points for U13 only. If there was one player in U9 and one in U11 they will still only be rewarded for their efforts in U13.
