JESSICA TURNBULL WINS GOLDEN OPEN IN KALGOORLIE

Queensland's Jessica Turnbull has broken through to win her maiden PSA title.

The 22 year old received an early birthday present when she beat Malaysian Wen Li Lai in four to take out the 2018 Golden Open in Kalgoorlie.

It was a strong performance by Turnbull to firstly beat #1 seed Sarah Cardwell in a tough semi final and then back up and defeat the Malaysian who had secured her place in the final by beating #2 seed Tamika Hunt (Saxby) 16-14 in the fourth.

Turnbull joined the PSA in 2010 and received an initial ranking of 252. She has now built that to #69 in the world (PSA July Rankings). She broke into the World Top 100 in July 2012.

For the past six years Turnbull's world ranking has hovered between 73 and 103. She has now broken into the Top 70 and has her sights set on breaking into the World Top 50.

It just shows persistence pays off.



KIRWAN TENPIN & SQUASH 2018 STATE SCHOOLS CHAMPIONSHIP

Ron Weatherby, President of Queensland School Squash, welcomed all players, parents, caregivers, friends and officials to Townsville and the Kirwan Tenpin and Squash for the 2018 Queensland School Squash Championships.

2018 is the 36th consecutive championships and the 12th year that the management committee has operated as Queensland School Squash, representing all squash players in all Queensland Schools.

The Management committee's objectives are to provide a championship that:

- Caters for all levels from elite to beginner
- ii) Maximises the number of times you are on the squash court playing in matches with similar ability level opponents and,
- iii) Provides as much fun as possible, hence more doubles.

The championships allow a school squash player to represent their Region, to compete as part of a team and to get recognition for their ability as players.

During the championships, players are selected to represent Queensland against New South Wales and New Zealand at the Trans-Tasman challenge and the Interstate Exchange in Sydney later this year.

A total of 107 players took part in 4 events with 63 boys and 44 girls participating: U19B (29), U19G (17), U15B (34) and U15G (27).
