CLUBS & CENTRES

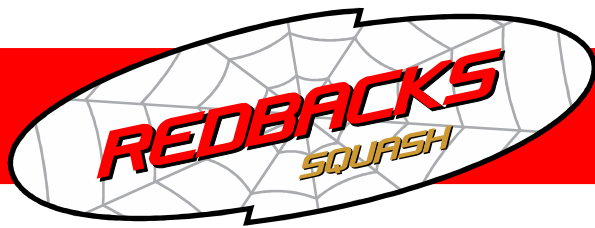

RANKINGS

Please look at the Q Squash website to check your ranking due on 1 October 2018. The appeal process in the policy provides for an internal review (like the old policy to give the rankers a chance to affirm or change their mind), and if the appellant remains aggrieved by that review decision, the appeal must be decided by an independent decision maker.

Australian Masters

Three players from Cairns attended the 2018 Australian Masters Squash Championships in Hobart.

Perhaps the cold climate might have kept some of the hot blooded NQ players away but nevertheless it was a fantastic tournament.

Marc Forster, Alan Zaeh and Meglin Rathnasamy along with former Cairns Player Chris Baker travelled down to play in their respective Age Groups.

Marc Forster defeated the #1 seed Richard Van Rynbach from NZ in 5 games 14-12, 11-4, 9-11, 4-11, 11-7 but lost the title on a count back. Forster went agonisingly close but lost on the last day to Victorian David Matchett 3-11, 11-7, 6-11, 11-6, 10-12.

Earlier Van Rynbach beat Matchett 9-11, 11-2, 11-4, 11-4.

In the 4 player round robin Forster (8 games won/6 games lost), Matchett (7 games won/6 games lost) and Van Rynbach (8 games won/6 games lost) all finished with 2 wins.

The tall New Zealand player Richard Van Rynbach won his first Australian Title beating Forster on a points differential (129 For and 109 Against = +20) compared to (130 For and 117 Against = +13).

Alan Zaeh, playing in Division 2 of the Over 45 event played solidly throughout and won the division without dropping a game.

Meglin Rathnasamy played his final on the final Day and with niggling injuries and his body hurting pulled off a brilliant victory to win the O35 Australian title 11-7, 9-11, 5-11, 11-9, 11-5 against Bill Doherty from Victoria.

A night of awards, food and conversation followed capping off a great week.

2019 looks big on the Gold Coast and will be well attended so get your entry in early if you're going.

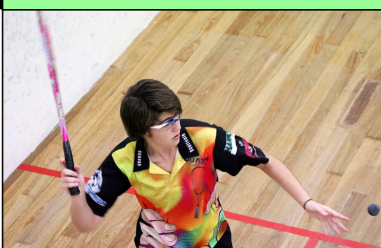

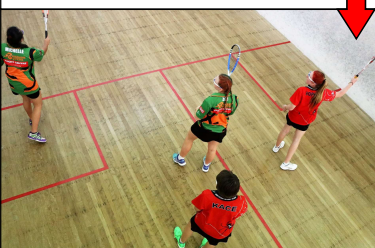

2018 REDSTAR AWARDS



In an effort to recognise more NR juniors we have revised our system of performance recognition. **From now on every placegetter (1-2-3) will be recognised.** Each winner of an aged event will be listed in the Achievement category and every player who finishes second or third will be listed in the Encouragement category.



Once a player has won an event they will be elevated and listed in the Achievement category even if they finish runner up or third in other events. If players are equal they will be listed in alphabetical order.

Players receive 3 points for winning a qualifier, 6 points for winning a Queensland State title and 9 points for winning a National title (AJO & AJC). Players will receive 2 points for finishing runner up in a qualifier, 4 points for runner up in a State final and 6 points for runner up in a National final. Players will receive 1 point for finishing third in a qualifier, 2 points for third in a State final and 3 points for third in a National event. U19 Players will also receive 1 bonus point for each result because they cannot enter 2 events.

Even though the Ingham qualifier was played in October 2017 it is still a 2018 qualifier so the results from that event will contribute to the **2018 NR Player of the Year Award**. A 2019 qualifier played in 2018 will not be included.

The player who accumulates the most points will be declared the Player of the Year. There will be joint winners if 2 players finish on the same number of points. The aim of the points system is to automate the selection and player results determine the outcome. The system is also designed to encourage players to support all events in their quest to accumulate points.

If an event is combined eg U17 and U19 Combined then it will be analysed to ensure points are allocated to both U17 and U19. A direct match up of the best two players in an age group will determine the winner of that age group. Otherwise the highest finishing position in an age group will receive the maximum points. **To be awarded points there must be at least two players competing in an age group.**

A player can only enter up to 2 events so they can only be rewarded with 2 results. An U9 player who might win a combined event eg **U9, U11 and U13 Combined** can only be rewarded for the U13 victory and their own age group U9 providing there are two U9 players competing. If there is only one player in U9 they will earn points for U13 only. If there was one player in U9 and one in U11 they will still only be rewarded for their efforts in U13.
