We wish them every success.









There will be a WA Squash **Extraordinary General Meeting** (EGM) held at the Terrace Squash center on Monday 15th October @ 6pm.





Note included in magazine: Two Serves Rule I assume this relates to the soon to be implemented the one serve rule which applies today.

Contribution from EGSRA Club -Host Club for 1983 (By Kath Harrington of SRA of WA)

1955 – Their first year of affiliation with the SRA of WA According to our records the first affiliated club was the Goldfields Squash Club. On the 20th July 1955 the Hon Secretary of the Goldfields Club, Mr Roy E Higgs applied for affiliation, advising that they were only a small club, newly formed, endeavouring to establish the game of squash on the Goldfields, and that affiliation with the SRA would be a wise move.

At a meeting held by the SRA on the 13th August 1955 the application received from the Goldfields Squash Club was accepted. Correspondence from the SRA to Goldfields Squash Club on 2 December 1955 confirmed this.

Mr Monty Jeffrey (SRA) advised them to appoint a delegate to attend SRA meetings. The delegate could be either a member of the Goldfields Club or a member of a club affiliated with the SRA (at this stage the SRA consisted of Adelphi Squash Club and This story continues to detail the wonderful history surrounding the Western Australia's Country Teams Squash Championships, better known as "**Country Week**".

Perth Squash Club).

The affiliation fee in 1955 was one shilling each for male members- obviously the Goldfields only had male members. Even in those days affiliation fees were overdue as the records show that the next correspondence received from Goldfields Squash Club on 10th April 1956 enclosed a cheque for one pound and one shilling being affiliation fees.

They also advised that the name of the club had been changed to the Goldfields Squash Rackets club. They had one court at Hannans Club, Brookman Street and that Mr Roy Higgs was still Secretary.

The first Goldfields Championships were held on 2 and 3 June 1956. Men's and Ladies singles - entry fee five shillings each.

Busselton Club

On Busselton's 150th anniversary the club decided to run its first tournament. The tournament was run over a normal weekend with teams from Bunbury, Mandurah, Bridgetown, Collie, Margaret River, Manjimup and Busselton.


Vale Mike Leeke
