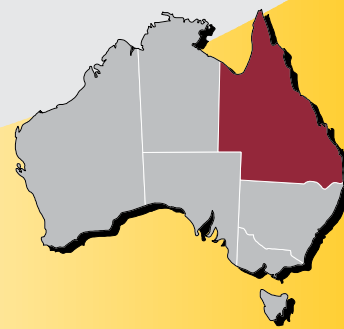

JANUARY: Madison Lyon and Mackenzie Sleep won titles at the Australian Junior Open played at Nerang. Lyon won the U13 title whilst Sleep won the U17 title. A great start to the year!

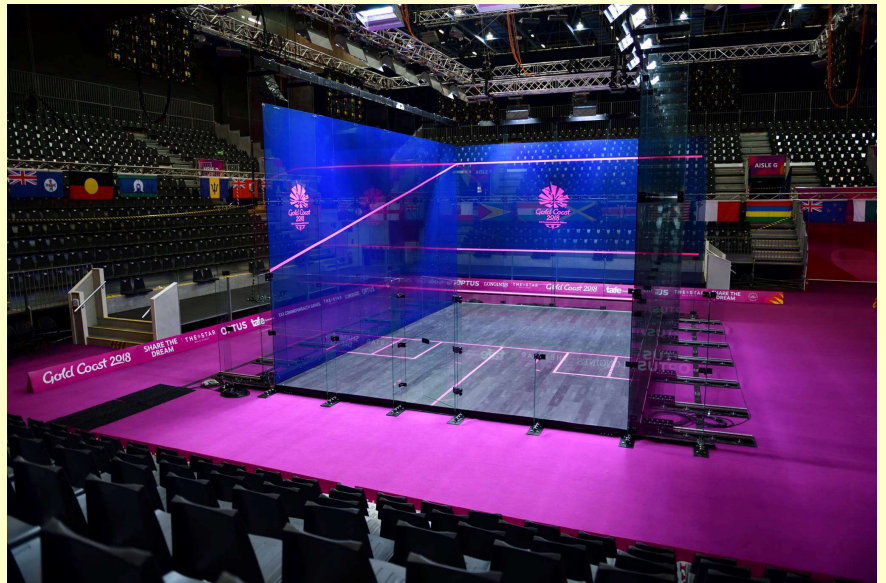
FEBRUARY: Alex Eustace combined with Rex Hedrick to win the Australian Doubles title in Darwin. Nick Calvert (Men's Premier) and Ella Burge (Women's A Grade) won Australian National Championship titles.

Nick Calvert won the Squash Australia Junior Player of the Year.

MARCH: Lisa Camilleri and Steve Finitsis participated in the Queen's Baton Relay.

APRIL: The wait was finally over. The 2018 Commonwealth Games were here at Movie World on the Gold Coast. Queensland was represented by Zac Alexander and Rachael Grinham. Both won medals!

Alexander teamed up with CG's legend David Palmer to win the Men's Doubles GOLD medal. I was in the audience that night and WOW ... it was pretty special.

Grinham partnered Donna Urquhart to win herself another BRONZE medal. Grinham has now won 2 Gold, 2 Silver and 4 Bronze medals from 5 Games.

Queensland put on a magnificent show. The referees and volunteers were absolutely fantastic. Well done to you all!

MAY: The Queensland Masters State Titles were run and won. Most notable was the Women's O45 final in which Aussie legend Sarah Fitz-Gerald played our very own Sue Davis in the final. Little did we know this was a preview of the World Masters Championship final in August.

JUNE: Jessica Turnbull won her maiden PSA title when she took out the 2018 Golden Open in Kalgoorlie. Turnbull was the only Queenslander to win a PSA title in 2018.

JULY: The QJC was successfully conducted in Rockhampton. The Northern Redbacks won the overall team title.



Joel Arscott, Nick Calvert, Ethan Eyles and Courtney Mather flew the Queensland flag at the 2018 World Junior Championships. Calvert was the only Queenslander to represent Australia in the teams. The Australian Junior Men's team finished 14th.

AUGUST: Brett Martin (O55) and Brian Cook (O70) won World titles at the 2018 World Masters Championship held in Charlottesville, Virginia. It was Cook's 5th World title and Martin's 1st. Melissa Martin (O40) and Sue Davis (O45) were Runners Up and Marilyn Kennedy (O70) finished 3rd.

SEPTEMBER: Brian Cook was still on fire winning his 23rd Australian Masters Crown when he won the O70 event at the AMC held in Hobart, Tasmania. Congratulations to all the Australian Masters champions from Queensland.

OCTOBER: The AJC was played in Darwin. Katie Davies (U17) and Ben Murray (U13) were crowned 2018 Australian Junior Champions.

Sadly, all good things eventually come to an end. Unfortunately, the Queensland Sharks couldn't extend their winning record past 14 straight Combined team titles.

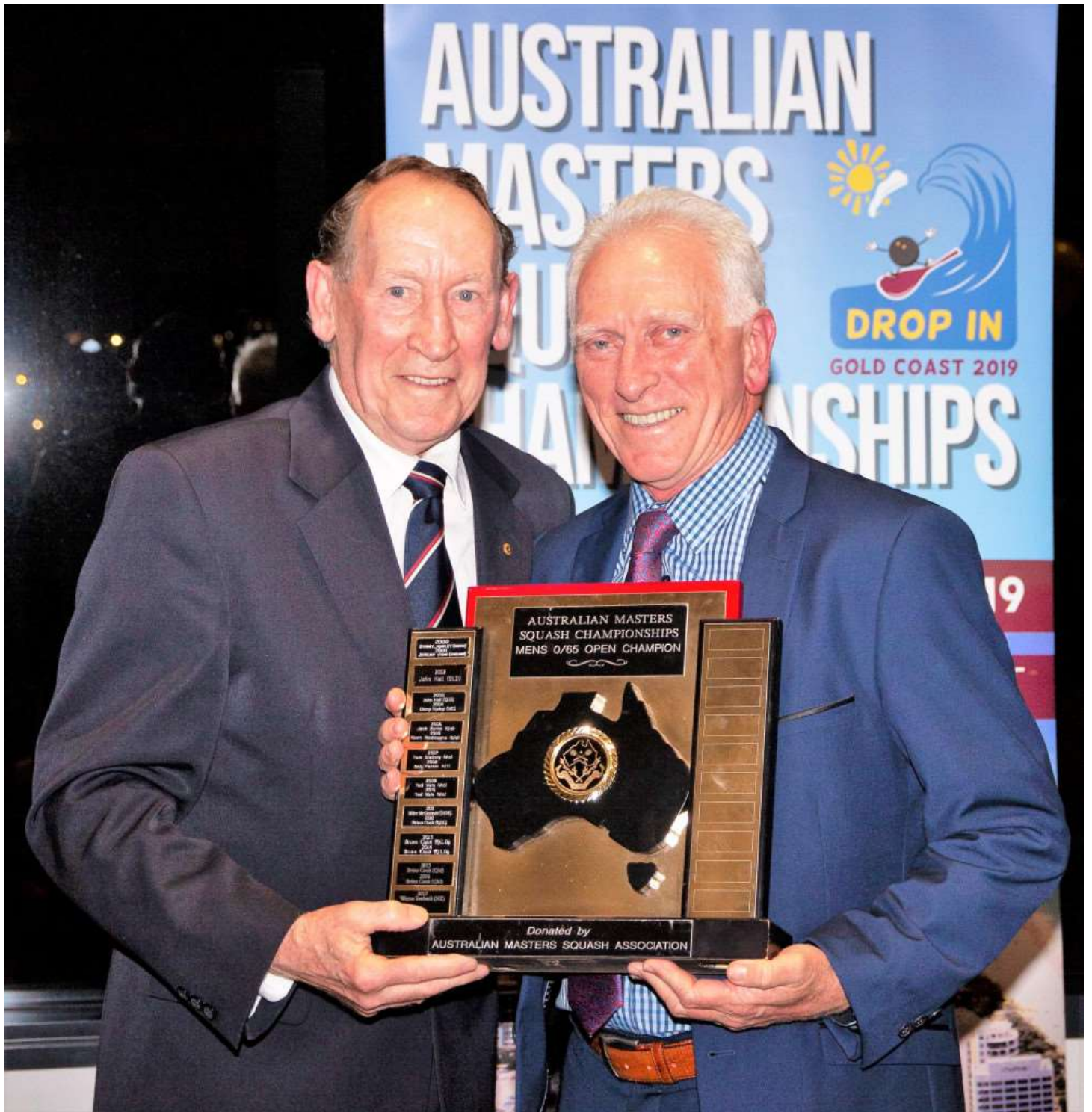

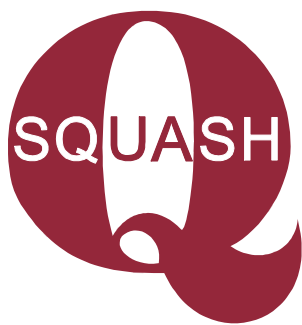

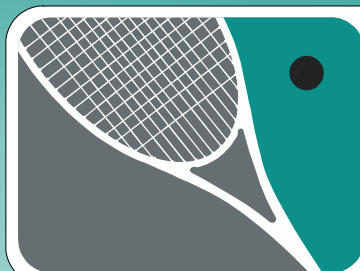

Happy New Year to all in Squash for 2019!

2018 was a big year for Southern Region Junior Squash with over 140 Squash juniors benefiting from 5 **Come Try Squash Development Days** made possible by an approved Get Going grant from the Department of Sport and Recreation from November 2017 to December 2018.

These days were hosted by Laidley, Southport, Maroochydore, Dalby and Gympie and were voted a huge success for local development in each of these junior programs. A big thank you to all of the host venues and to the local squash community who rallied support for these programs.

This program was part of a Two Year Strategic Plan by Q Squash Southern Region Inc and have also provided the opportunity for coach development with local coaches gaining experience under Head Coach Robyn Prentice. This will be continued during 2019 with fund raising efforts already under way.

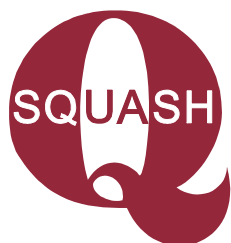

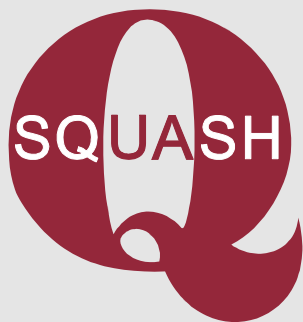

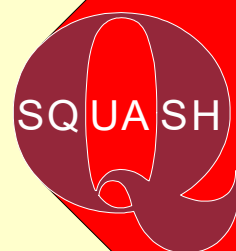
