














WJC 2016–2018 Bringing Back Some Memories

Q SQUASH NEWS EDITORIAL

Without sounding negative it is very hard to get excited about the Australian Squash Tour for 2019. There are now fewer events and too many CLOSED events.

It is alarming from the perspective that players will now be forced to go overseas to chase world ranking points and competition. There is no real incentive to play in Australia.

Taking out closed events which attract minimal PSA points, so far the calendar for men is looking like this: March 30 MC 5 Elanora, May 31 MC 5 Golden Open, June 26 MC 5 Victorian Open, July 3 MC 10 Australian Open, July 12 MC 10 Tasmanian Open, Aug 1 MC 5 Bendigo Open and finally at this stage Aug 21 MC 5 Shepparton International = 7 events!

For the women it is even worse: May 3 WC 5 Sandgate Open, May 31 WC 5 Golden Open, June 26 WC 5 Victorian Open, July 3 WC 10 Australian Open and Aug 1 WC 5

Some clubs/centres have simply not announced their event for 2019. Please do so ASAP.

Besides sponsorship another impact on whether a promoter decides to run an event or not is the currency exchange. Prizemoney is given out in US Dollars. Currently, the Aussie Dollar is low in comparison to the USD so there is an increased financial risk for promoters. They either have to get more sponsorship or reduce what they offer or abandon offering an event completely.

Today, one Aussie dollar will buy you approximately 0.70 USD. In other words a USD 5,000 Challenger is effectively a AUD 7,142 event. A USD 10,000 Challenger or two USD 5,000 events (one for men and one for women) equates to AUD 14,284!

Please be advised that elections will be held for all board positions at the upcoming Q Squash Annual General Meeting, to be held on Saturday 23 March 2019.

Six (6) Director positions (one-year term) - President and Five Directors

We're moving into a challenging time for the sport in Queensland. Change is required to bring our administration and sport up to date and relevant for our game to grow. We will need to introduce new programs, to bring more kids into our sport and encourage them to continue the sport for life. Engagement with state and local government needs to be strengthened, to provide Squash with more opportunities in high demand areas of Queensland.

Q Squash needs to revise the Board constitution, update its Governance and policies and develop the next Strategic Plan for 2018 – 2021 with the vision for Squash to be Queensland's most engaging sport.

Ensuring good governance of the organisation, elected Directors will play a significant role overseeing the implementation of the Operational Plan as well as supporting our regions, volunteers and stakeholders through new opportunities and challenges as we work to engage more Queenslanders in our sport.

This is a terrific opportunity for strong leaders who have a genuine interest and passion for advancing the sport of Squash across all of Queensland to contribute. Courtney Mather Courtney Mather Taylor Jones Lakeesha Rarere Lakeesha Rarere Our most recent champion was **Nick Calvert**. Nick finished his junior career as #1 in Australia and played in the 2018 World Junior Championships.

He won 6 Queensland Junior Championship titles.

Today, Nick is looking to see how far he can go on the PSA World Tour. He is currently ranked 228 but should break into the Top 200 in 2019.

Courtney Mather has also bowed out of juniors after winning 6 State Titles. She is also on the professional circuit and is currently ranked 184. Courtney has also played at the World Junior Championships and represented Australia.

Queensland has been very strong in U19 age group for a number of years. From 2012 to 2016 the Sharks U19 Team won 5 Australian Junior Team Titles. Our team in 2017 finished 2nd and our 2018 team finished 4th.

Alex Eustace (5 State Titles) won the Individual U19 Australian Title in 2015 and 2016 and **Nick Calvert** won the 2017 National Title. **Lakeesha Rarere** (11 State Titles) won the Australian U19 title in 2014 and 2015.

Are you aware of the Containers For Change Scheme?


Lets reduce the waste your centre needs to dispose of and ultimately, reduce costs, take care of the environment and fundraise for your junior club.


