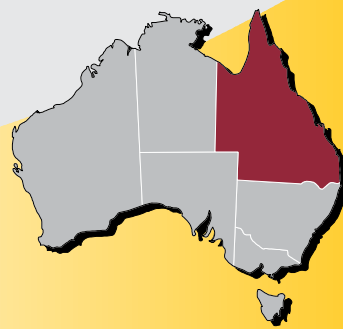

## QJC ... A BLAST FROM THE PAST

As the 2019 Queensland Junior Championships loom on the horizon it always brings back fond memories of our past champions. This month we will look at our U17 Champions.

Mackay's **Wes Dyer** and **Hayley Hankinson** won the U17 titles in 2018. Wes is a strong contender to step up and win the U19 title but sadly, Hayley hasn't been sighted at the NR qualifiers in 2019.

**Ethan Eyles** is representing Australia (U17) in the Trans Tasman Test Series in New Zealand in April. If he is at the QJC this year he will be a hot favourite to take the title again.

Providing Mackenzie Sleep (2018 AJO U17 Champion) competes she too will be a hot favourite to enjoy success.

Our past champion boys **Alex Eustace** (2014) and **Nick Calvert** (2015 and 2016) both stepped up in their final junior years and became #1 in Australia. Eustace won the U19 title in 2014 and 2016. Calvert won the coveted U19 title in 2018.

**Emily Turner** won in 2014 and **Taylor Jones** won in 2015 and 2016. Emily quietly retired whilst Taylor Jones stepped up and won the U19 title in 2016. The competition bridged the gap in 2017 with Taylor beaten by a younger opponent (Mackenzie Sleep) in the U19 semi.

In summary the U17 title is a tough title to win. The boys are becoming young men. They are generally much taller and stronger compared to when they were in U15. The rallies are getting longer and fitness is now really coming into play.

The girls too are getting much stronger but also debating their futures. It is a decision making time for both sexes. They are both at a crossroads. Players begin to make important life changing decisions about their futures. Not everyone has the ability nor the commitment to become a professional squash player. Most players choose to pursue a tertiary education or enter the workforce.

However, if you do have the ability and the commitment to become a professional squash player I urge you to give it a go. **You only have one window of opportunity in life to do it.** You can always study and enter the workforce in the future. Providing you have the support of family and the financial means to give it a go then pursue your dream!
