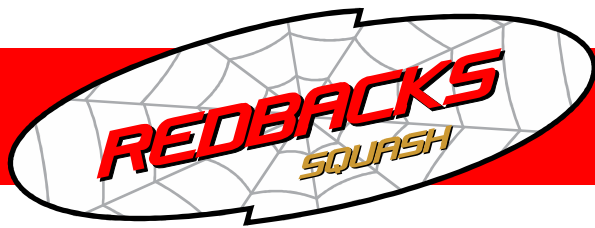

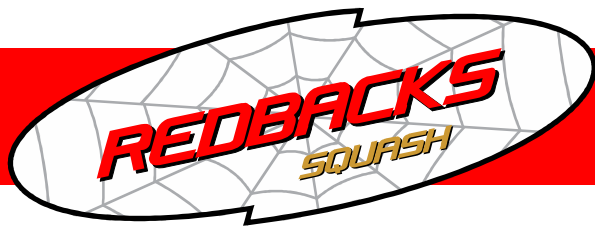

Congratulations to Wes Dyer, Kurstyn Mather and Josh Porter for achieving the title of Queensland School Champions in your respective age groups.

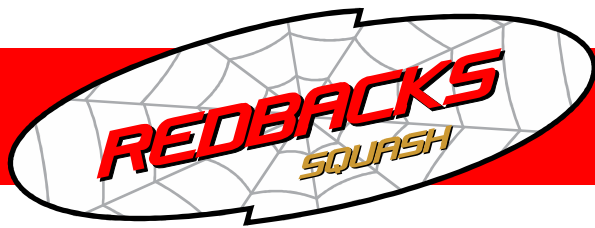
NR JUNIOR TOURNAMENTS

The NR Committee has recently called for clubs to provide their expression of interest to host the 2020 Season Junior Tournaments.

The Junior Tournament dates are:

Ingham	TBC August or 19/20 Oct 2019	Venue: Ingham Squash Centre
Mackay	15/16 Feb 2020	Venue: TBC
Townsville	14/15 Mar 2020	Venue: TBC
NR Closed	2/3 May 2020	Venue: Sportsworld Cairns

Please note Mackay and Cairns are the compulsory tournaments. To qualify for selection for the Redbacks team, juniors must play three (3) of the four (4) NR Junior tournaments. A junior must play both compulsory tournaments in Cairns and Mackay

and at least 1 tournament in Ingham or Townsville. Juniors who meet this criteria will be given priority consideration when the Redbacks are selected regardless of strength of an individual who has not fully qualified or strength of the overall team. Please do not assume you will be selected for the Northern Redbacks if you have not qualified by attending the required tournaments or have not provided medical evidence to remain eligible.

AFFILIATION IS DUE

Particularly important if in January you affiliated for 6 months, your affiliation fees will now be due again. Affiliation fees: \$73 for a full 1 year; or \$44 for seasonal (6 months). Please remember affiliation comes with all sorts of benefits – especially personal insurance with participating in the game or related activity. Affiliation is compulsory for all juniors to compete in the NR Junior tournaments and in the State and National Championships. Affiliation status will be checked prior to all 2019 NR Junior Squash Championships.

Please note players living in Mackay, Townsville, Ingham and Cairns and all areas in between along the coast are not considered remote and do not qualify for the Remote Member Registration.

RANKINGS

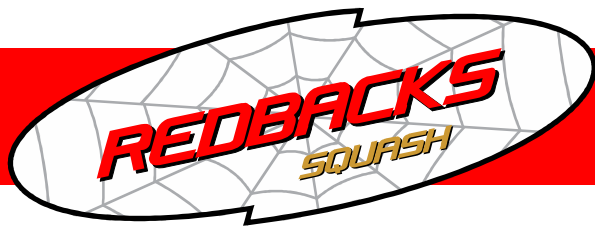
The Queensland junior rankings were due on 1 June 2019.

The State rankings and associated combined seedings will be relied upon by the NR tournament hosts to set draws. Timely appeals will be essential. The appeal process in the policy provides for an internal review (like the old policy to give the rankers a chance to affirm or change their mind), and if the appellant remains aggrieved by that review decision, the appeal must be decided by an independent decision maker.

NORTHERN REGION MEETING

Please note a standard item on the NR Meeting Agenda will be a discussion about participation in the NR. This item will be to share ideas about how to increase participation in the NR and how to continue to improve the competition. Please attend the meetings to share your ideas. We had a great discussion at the Mackay meeting and it would have been a more fruitful discussion if we had more members involved.

The next meeting will be at the 2019 Ingham Junior Championships and the date will be advised.

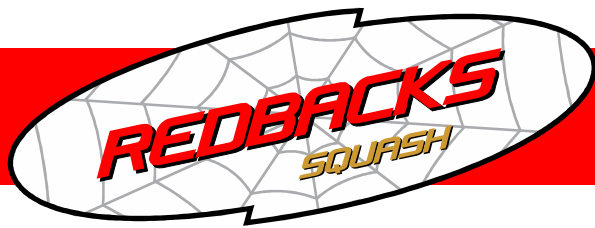

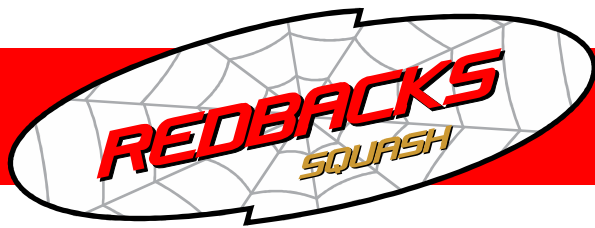
FUNDING/GRANTS

It would be really great if we could get at least 1 person from each centre in the NR to form a sub committee to co-ordinate applying for grants. We will continue to apply for grants as the NR however, if we apply for grants for each centre the NR will benefit with the opportunity to win many more grants and we will have so much more money to go towards promotion of squash and junior development within the NR.

If we work as a team we could collectively be very successful for a minimal amount of time and effort. We would work on common goals within the region and share the content we write for each grant. This would reduce the amount of work we need to do independently and increase our chances of receiving money to spend within the region.

I believe the priority for NR would be to apply for grants to increase participation with a focus on new members but also retaining current members and increasing the coaching standard and availability of high quality coaching across the NR. As the NR covers a very large geographical area we have unique challenges and grant money is one solution to overcome some of the challenges.

Gillian Nielsen Reports:

The timber to refurbish three of our courts has finally arrived after a long boat trip from Denmark. We were initially hoping to have the flooring done by Easter time, but this was not to be. Luckily, it arrived on a day that I wasn't at the courts, so the unloading was done by Matt and Karl Brazier, Ben Courtice and James Toohey. Apparently, the timber is fairly heavy and much sweating was done in the transfer off the truck.

We have our builder lined up for installation within the next couple of months and there will be volunteers called for to help with the removal of the old flooring. I recently looked at the number of nails used in the old flooring and there seems to be a fairly large amount that will need to be removed. Ben may have plans to incorporate removal with one of his Saturday morning boot camps!

It would not have been possible for the Club to purchase the flooring without the support of both the State and Federal members in the form of community grants. Thank you.

To celebrate the new floors, the Club will be holding a Graded Doubles tournament in September.

Club members have also been travelling to Moranbah to compete in their annual tournament. Numbers were slightly down this year, but the committee out there is remaining positive for a turnaround in numbers next year.

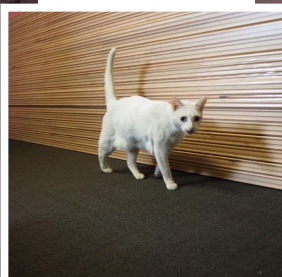

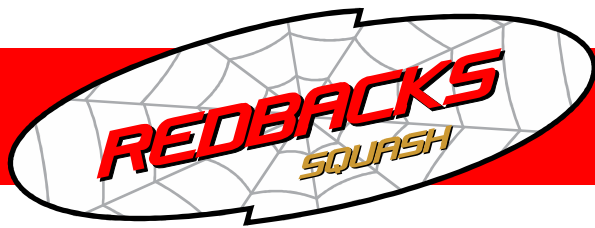
Townsville and Rockhampton tournaments are also on the agenda for our players with the 52 Open to be held on the first Friday, Saturday and Sunday of November.

2018 REDSTAR AWARDS



Our aim is to recognise as many NR juniors as we can with the **RedStar** Performance Recognition System. **Every placegetter (1-2-3) will be recognised.** Each winner of an aged event will be listed in the Achievement category and every player who finishes second or third will be listed in the Encouragement category.



Once a player has won an event they will be elevated and listed in the Achievement category even if they finish runner up or third in other events. If players are equal they will be listed in alphabetical order.

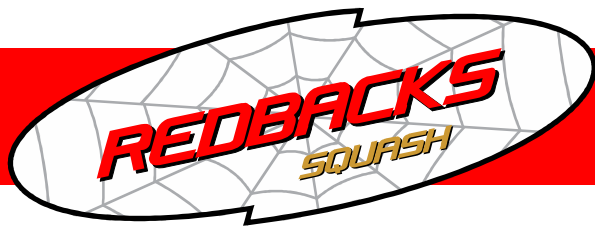
Players receive 3 points for winning a qualifier, 6 points for winning a Queensland State title and 9 points for winning a National title (AJO & AJC). Players will receive 2 points for finishing runner up in a qualifier, 4 points for runner up in a State final and 6 points for runner up in a National final. Players will receive 1 point for finishing third in a qualifier, 2 points for third in a State final and 3 points for third in a National event. U19 Players will also receive 1 bonus point for each result because they cannot enter 2 events.

Even though the Ingham qualifier was played in October 2018 it is still a 2019 qualifier so the results from that event will contribute to the **2019 NR Player of the Year Award**. A 2019 qualifier played in 2018 will not be included.

The player who accumulates the most points will be declared the Player of the Year. There will be joint winners if 2 players finish on the same number of points. The aim of the points system is to automate the selection and player results determine the outcome. The system is also designed to encourage players to support all events in their quest to accumulate points.

If an event is combined eg U17 and U19 Combined then it will be analysed to ensure points are allocated to both U17 and U19. A direct match up of the best two players in an age group will determine the winner of that age group. Otherwise the highest finishing position in an age group will receive the maximum points. **To be awarded points there must be at least two players competing in an age group.**

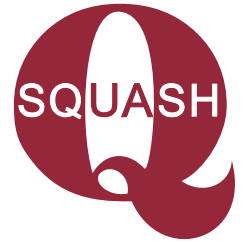
A player can only enter up to 2 events so they can only be rewarded with 2 results. An U9 player who might win a combined event eg **U9, U11 and U13 Combined** can only be rewarded for the U13 victory and their own age group U9 providing there are two U9 players competing. If there is only one player in U9 they will earn points for U13 only. If there was one player in U9 and one in U11 they will still only be rewarded for their efforts in U13.
