No rest for the dedicated though as things ramp up again ahead of the AJC in Tasmania which is coming up fast on the horizon.

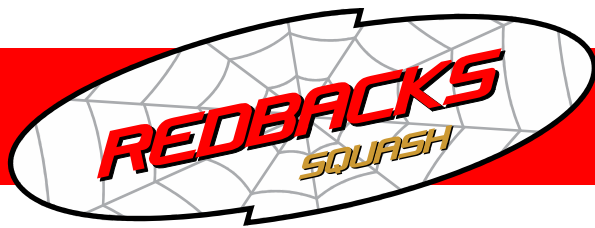

Please note Mackay and Cairns are the compulsory tournaments. To qualify for selection to the Redbacks team, juniors must play three (3) of the four (4) NR Junior tournaments. A junior must

play both compulsory tournaments in Cairns and Mackay and at least 1 tournament in Ingham or Townsville. Juniors who meet this criteria will be given priority consideration when the Redbacks are selected regardless of strength of an individual who has not fully qualified or strength of the overall team. Please do not assume you will be selected to the Northern Redbacks if you have not qualified by attending the required tournaments or have not provided medical evidence to remain eligible.

AFFILIATION IS DUE

Particularly important if in January you affiliated for 6 months, your affiliation fees will now be due again. Affiliation fees: \$73 for a full 1 year; or \$44 for seasonal (6 months).

Please remember affiliation comes with all sorts of benefits – especially personal insurance with participating in the game or related activity. Affiliation is compulsory for all juniors to compete in the NR Junior tournaments and in the State and National Championships. Affiliation status will be checked prior to all 2019 NR Junior Squash Championships.

Please note players living in Mackay, Townsville, Ingham and Cairns and all areas in between along the coast are not considered remote and do not qualify for the Remote Member Registration.

RANKINGS

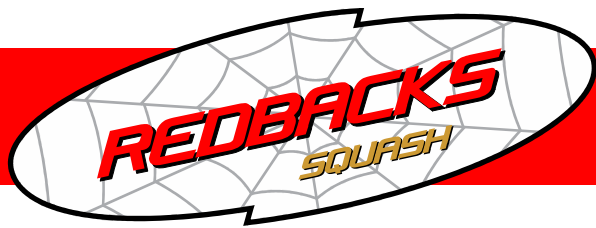
The Queensland junior rankings were due on 1 August 2019. These will need to be followed up. Sounds like a job for the VP!

The State rankings and associated combined seedings will be relied upon by the Northern Region tournament hosts to set draws. Timely appeals will be essential. The appeal process in the policy provides for an internal review (like the old policy to give the rankers a chance to affirm or change their mind), and if the appellant remains aggrieved by that review decision, the appeal must be decided by an independent decision maker.

NORTHERN REGION MEETING

Please note a standard item on the NR Meeting Agenda will be a discussion about participation in the NR. This item will be to share ideas about how to increase participation in the NR and how to continue to improve the competition. Please attend the meetings to share your ideas. The more people we have at the table the more ideas we will have to consider. We really need ideas to improve the participation in the region.

The next meeting will be at the 2019 Ingham Junior Championships.

NR COACHING CLINIC

We decided to run a NR coaching clinic in Townsville on 10/11 August. This was at very short notice. We will consider further coaching clinics in the near future. I think coaching clinics are going to be important in the NR in the coming years. We need to share our resources within the NR to increase the opportunity for all juniors and anyone who wants to play squash.

I appreciate Marc Forster giving up his time to travel to Townsville to run this clinic, after only just returning from the Pacific Games. Thanks also to Scott Menta who is going to assist Marc over the weekend. In the future these clinics will be open to all juniors at any level from beginners to Redbacks and Sharks. As the NR covers such a large area and it is very expensive to travel, grant money would be very useful to subsidise costs for everyone to attend.

FUNDING/GRANTS

The NR committee are considering using a professional Grant Writer. If you have any knowledge in this area or any contacts please contact me with details.

We will still need support from each centre to complete grants and it would be really great if we could get at least 1 person from each centre in the NR region to form a sub committee to co-ordinate applying for grants or working with a Grant Writer. Applying for grants as the NR is great and we will continue to do so. However, if we apply for grants for each centre the NR will benefit with the opportunity to win many more grants and have so much more money to go towards promotion of squash and junior development within the NR.

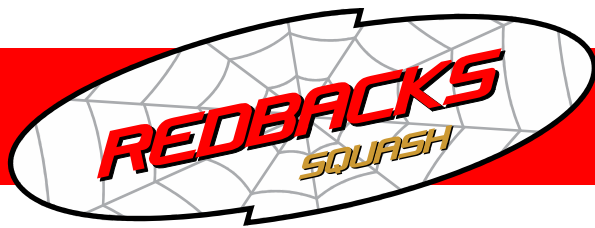
If we work as a team we could collectively be very successful for a minimal amount of time and effort. We would work on common goals within the region and share the content we write for each grant. This would reduce the amount of work we need to do independently and increase our chances of receiving money to spend within the region.

I believe the priority for NR would be to apply for grants to increase participation with a focus on new members but also retaining current members and increasing the coaching standard and availability of high quality coaching across the NR. As the NR covers a very large geographical area we have unique challenges and grant money is 1 solution to overcome some of the challenges.

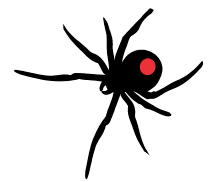


Junior Update

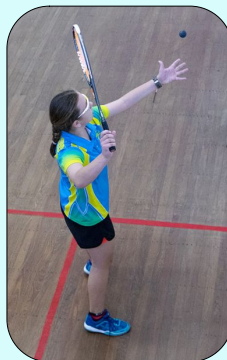


Nomination fees for the 2019/2020 Northern Region Junior Qualifiers:

2018 REDSTAR AWARDS



Our aim is to recognise as many NR juniors as we can with the **RedStar** Performance Recognition System. **Every placegetter (1-2-3) will be recognised.** Each winner of an aged event will be listed in the Achievement category and every player who finishes second or third will be listed in the Encouragement category.



Once a player has won an event they will be elevated and listed in the Achievement category even if they finish runner up or third in other events. If players are equal they will be listed in alphabetical order.

Players receive 3 points for winning a qualifier, 6 points for winning a Queensland State title and 9 points for winning a National title (AJO & AJC). Players will receive 2 points for finishing runner up in a qualifier, 4 points for runner up in a State final and 6 points for runner up in a National final. Players will receive 1 point for finishing third in a qualifier, 2 points for third in a State final and 3 points for third in a National event. U19 Players will also receive 1 bonus point for each result because they cannot enter 2 events.

Even though the Ingham qualifier was played in October 2018 it is still a 2019 qualifier so the results from that event will contribute to the **2019 NR Player of the Year Award**. A 2019 qualifier played in 2018 will not be included.

The player who accumulates the most points will be declared the Player of the Year. There will be joint winners if 2 players finish on the same number of points. The aim of the points system is to automate the selection and player results determine the outcome. The system is also designed to encourage players to support all events in their quest to accumulate points.

If an event is combined eg U17 and U19 Combined then it will be analysed to ensure points are allocated to both U17 and U19. A direct match up of the best two players in an age group will determine the winner of that age group. Otherwise the highest finishing position in an age group will receive the maximum points. **To be awarded points there must be at least two players competing in an age group.**

A player can only enter up to 2 events so they can only be rewarded with 2 results. An U9 player who might win a combined event eg **U9, U11 and U13 Combined** can only be rewarded for the U13 victory and their own age group U9 providing there are two U9 players competing. If there is only one player in U9 they will earn points for U13 only. If there was one player in U9 and one in U11 they will still only be rewarded for their efforts in U13.
