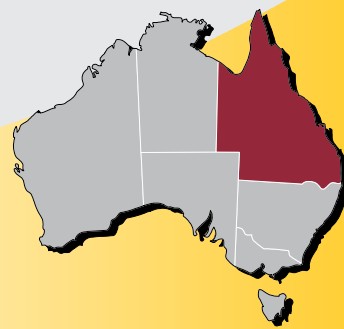

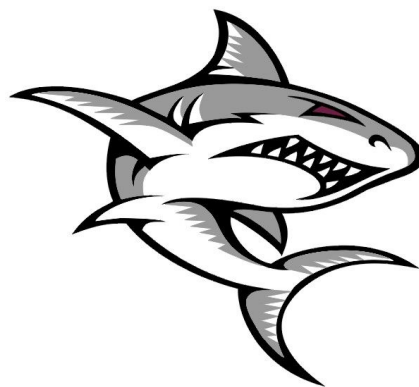

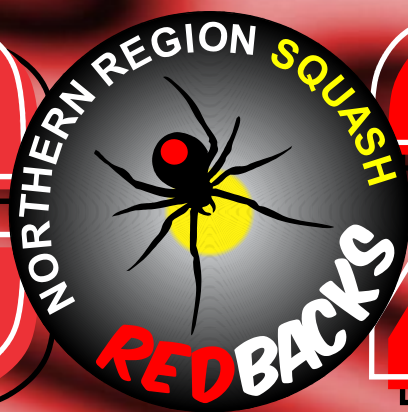
A strong Sharks team has been put together to take back the Overall Team title they lost last year to Western Australia.

Nathan Turnbull and Steve Finitsis are the coaches and Jules Wone is the Manager.

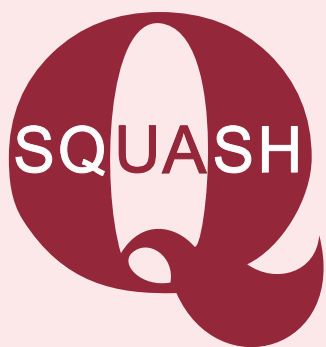
