Lisa went on to win 12 State Titles. Let's hope Hayley goes on to do the same.





STEVE FINITSIS REACHES SF IN VIC OPEN


Innisfail's **Steve Finitsis** is currently back in Australia to compete in the Victorian and Australian Opens. Welcome home Big Steve!!!






The Individual Championship runs from Saturday 26th to Tuesday 29th September 2015. This is a CLOSED event for Australian & Permanent Resident Junior Players.

Brody was undefeated throughout the tournament.

The Queensland team will now take on NSW and New Zealand in the Trans-Tasman Tri-Series in Sydney from 24-27th August.



It was then time to face her biggest challenge against the #1 seed Christine Nunn.

Lisa began well taking the first two games
11-4 and 11-9 but that effort had a telling effect
and Lisa lost the next two 2-11 and 5-11.

Lisa was able to push her opponent a little harder in the 5th but it wasn't enough to stop the momentum Nunn had created. Lisa lost the last 8-11

Lisa commented after her match:

"I lost 3-2 but it was a very good match. Completely dominated the first 2 games then got a little winded.

Christine began playing straighter and chased everything down. I just couldn't get back to controlling the tempo of the match.

Overall, very happy with my first tournament back after 5 months out."

Nunn went on to win the title 3-0 beating South African 3rd seed Cheyna Tucker 11-6 11-2 11-2.


