AUSTRALIAN JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS (AJC)

CONGRATULATIONS QUEENSLAND SHARKS: 2019 National Champions

Congratulations to Brendan MacDonald who achieved one of his personal goals becoming the 2019 U17 Boys National Champion. Brendan was undefeated in the individuals and the teams and was awarded the Austin Adarraga trophy by the Queensland coaches for best male Queensland player. Brendan also was second in the MC Hazel award, which is voted on during the AJC Individual event by Managers and Referees.

NR JUNIOR TOURNAMENTS

Nominations for the Ingham Junior Tournament have been extended. Ingham is always a tricky tournament to get everyone nominated due to everyone being wrapped up in their school holidays or the AJC.

Rob Fadaely will be the Junior Tournament Co-Ordinator for the 2020 NR Season. Each club hosting a NR junior tournament will nominate a Tournament Director to work with Rob.

Please note Mackay and Cairns are the compulsory tournaments. To qualify for selection to the Redbacks team, juniors must play three (3) of the four (4) NR Junior tournaments. A junior must play both compulsory tournaments in Cairns and Mackay and at least 1 tournament in Ingham or Townsville. Juniors who meet this criteria will be given priority consideration when the Redbacks are selected regardless of strength of an individual who has not fully qualified or strength of the overall team. Please do not assume you will be selected to the Northern Redbacks if you have not qualified by attending the required tournaments or have not provided medical evidence to remain eligible.

2020 QUEENSLAND JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

The QJC to be held in Cairns in June/July 2020 will soon be discussed and the management team will be announced.

AFFILIATION WITH Q SQUASH

Please be aware affiliations will again be due in January 2020.

Affiliation is compulsory for all juniors to compete in the NR Junior tournaments and in the State and National Championships. Affiliation status will be checked prior to all 2020 season NR Junior tournaments and the Queensland Junior Championships.

Affiliation fees: \$73 for a full 1 year; or \$44 for seasonal (6 months). Please remember affiliation comes with all sorts of benefits – especially personal insurance with participating in the game or related activity, such as fundraising.

Please note players living in Mackay, Townsville, Ingham and Cairns and all areas in between along the coast are not considered remote and do not qualify for the Remote Member Registration.

RANKINGS

The State junior rankings and associated combined seedings will be relied upon by the NR tournament hosts to set draws. Timely appeals will be essential. The appeal process in the policy provides for an internal review (like the old policy to give the rankers a chance to affirm or change their mind), and if the appellant remains aggrieved by that review decision, the appeal must be decided by an independent decision maker.

Rhys has been so patient and more than understanding of my very limited knowledge about IT. It is intended live streaming of matches will take place at club fixtures, junior and open tournaments, PSA events, coaching clinics and any events to promote squash, sponsors and supporters.

The NR recently applied for the Qantas Regional Grant for financial and flight support for existing players, to encourage new participation and building the networks in the region beyond the current boundaries from Cairns to Mackay. I'll be sure to advise the outcome of this grant. Thanks also to President Dean Morzone and Treasurer Dan Ackroyd from Sportsworld Squash Club in Cairns who also made a submission for this funding.

Currently Squash Australia are also offering all squash clubs the opportunity to have support to apply for grants. For more information about this George Clinton is the Community Facilities Coordinator with SA and can be contacted by email: <u>facilities@squash.org.au</u> and mobile: 0434 129 441.

Please contact me if you would like to be involved or can contribute in any way to the NR efforts to apply for grants.

Also if your club is not already recycling, please seriously consider doing this. It really is \$\$ for rubbish. Cairns Junior Squash (with Rob Fadaely in charge) has been recycling for over 12 months and it has been very fruitful and taken some pressure off the parents to do other fundraising. I'm sure funds raised would be well over \$1,000, maybe closer to \$1,500. Cairns Juniors also do Bunnings sausage sizzle days and on average raise \$1,500 in one day. Unfortunately, we have to wait for our turn! Please consider getting a group together to fundraise for your club.

SPORTYHQ

Squash Australia (SA) have advised that SA will cover subscription cost for affiliated clubs. Please do not pay for any SportyHQ subscriptions prior to discussing your clubs status and encourage all your club members to pay their affiliations to take advantage of this. In regard to SportyHQ, SA announced a number of other improvements are coming to provide a better user experience and there will be 6 monthly updates.

NR VOLUNTEERS

As we move into the 2020 squash season, I start to think about the junior tournaments and this means lots of work. Our tournament standards have lifted over the past 2 years. We now have sponsors for each tournament, we sell tournament shirts and other merchandise to promote our sponsors, we have Saturday night NR sponsored dinners and SportyHQ is the official platform for managing the tournaments. We need more people involved in the administration of our tournaments to increase our

Nathan Turnbull said he started his involvement as a referee when he was about 15yo and he is now regarded as one of Australia's most competent squash referees.



Former World #45 **Steve Finitsis (Qld)** won the prestigious Australian Masters Over 35 Men's Open title at his first attempt.


Simon Carruthers (NSW) was runner up with Big Steve beating him 11-6, 13-11, 11-9 during the 5-person round robin match ups.

JOHN WHITE




He may have represented the USA at this year's Australian Masters but he was born in Mt Isa so let's recognise the achievements of the legendary **John White**!



Gillian Nielsen Reports:

It has been just over 12 months since 52 Squash & Fitness Club began the process of applying for grants to replace the flooring on 3 of our courts. It seemed to take forever for the timber to arrive on what seemed a slow boat from Denmark, but when it appeared one sunny day, it was well worth the wait!

The plan was to rip up the old flooring and lay the new in 3 sessions. Court 6 was the first lucky recipient of timber with Ben helping to rip up the old just hours before he headed to Rockhampton to compete in their annual tournament. He possibly handicapped his



hamstrings for the weekend, but still managed to place Runner-up in the Open final.

Next to go was Court 1 with a working bee of some of our members. A big thank you to Kerry, Karl and Matthew Brazier, Terry Hoani-Vincent, James Toohey, Chris Chambers, Ben Courtice and Dan Wagner for helping to get the job done in around 6 hours.

You would be surprised at the amount of dust and other stuff that accumulates under floor boards after 50 years of service. There are also an awful lot of nails used to hold the floorboards down too, just ask Matthew and Karl who somehow managed to volunteer to remove them all!

Flooring went down when our trusty builder was back in town with the help of his dad and Ben who put in a full day's work to lay the new floors.

Which left us with just the lucky last Court 5 ... (I had a moment of panic when I looked at the amount of timber that was left and hoped that we had ordered enough to get the job done). Another working bee by the Saturday boys and all was ready for the final laying, a couple of days wait for Scotty our builder, and then full steam ahead to finish the job.

The new flooring looks crisp and clean compared to the two remaining floors which means that we will have to sharpen the pencils again and apply for funding to replace these floors in the future.

Of course, the new flooring would not have been possible without the following grants

- Community Benefits Gambling Fund (State Government)
- Stronger Communities Funding (Federal Government)

The next tournament to be held at 52 will be the annual 52 Open on 2nd & 3rd of November, nominations will be capped at 80 this year, so get yours in asap. The Courtice family will be supplying a bbq dinner at the courts on Saturday night with the Xmas party moving on to The Met to continue celebrations. This year's theme is Iconic Figures in History, so get your name in and your costume sorted.

2018 REDSTAR AWARDS



Our aim is to recognise as many NR juniors as we can with the **RedStar** Performance Recognition System. **Every placegetter (1-2-3) will be recognised.** Each winner of an aged event will be listed in the Achievement category and every player who finishes second or third will be listed in the Encouragement category.



Once a player has won an event they will be elevated and listed in the Achievement category even if they finish runner up or third in other events. If players are equal they will be listed in alphabetical order.

Players receive 3 points for winning a qualifier, 6 points for winning a Queensland State title and 9 points for winning a National title (AJO & AJC). Players will receive 2 points for finishing runner up in a qualifier, 4 points for runner up in a State final and 6 points for runner up in a National final. Players will receive 1 point for finishing third in a qualifier, 2 points for third in a State final and 3 points for third in a National event. U19 Players will also receive 1 bonus point for each result because they cannot enter 2 events.

Even though the Ingham qualifier was played in October 2018 it is still a 2019 qualifier so the results from that event will contribute to the **2019 NR Player of the Year Award.** A 2019 qualifier played in 2018 will not be included.

The player who accumulates the most points will be declared the Player of the Year. There will be joint winners if 2 players finish on the same number of points. The aim of the points system is to automate the selection and player results determine the outcome. The system is also designed to encourage players to support all events in their quest to accumulate points.

If an event is combined eg U17 and U19 Combined then it will be analysed to ensure points are allocated to both U17 and U19. A direct match up of the best two players in an age group will determine the winner of that age group. Otherwise the highest finishing position in an age group will receive the maximum points. **To be awarded points there must be at least two players competing in an age group.**

A player can only enter up to 2 events so they can only be rewarded with 2 results. An U9 player who might win a combined event eg **U9**, **U11 and U13 Combined** can only be rewarded for the U13 victory and their own age group U9 providing there are two U9 players competing. If there is only one player in U9 they will earn points for U13 only. If there was one player in U9 and one in U11 they will still only be rewarded for their efforts in U13.
