IMPORTANT UPDATE from Q Squash: Player Affiliation Fees for 2020

Due to COVID-19 forced closures this year players have missed out on several weeks of their affiliation playing benefits and so the Board has decided to roll over this year's affiliations into next year. Whether you have already paid affiliation this year or have still to pay for it, the following changes apply:

- 1. The 2020 12 month player affiliation now expires on March 10th 2021, instead of the original 31st Dec 2020 expiry date.
- 2. The 2020 (Jan June) 6 month affiliation plan now expires on 10th Sep 2020, instead of the original 30th June 2020 expiry.
- 3. The second 6 months of the 2020 year (Jul Dec) will be due on 10th Sep 2020 and will expire on 10th March 2021.
- 4. Seasonal affiliation fees are still being discussed and will depend on the fixtures season in your region. More to come on that in the next few weeks.
- 5. We have introduced a remote player affiliation option, this is a discounted affiliation option for players who play at a location that is at least 300kms from the Eastern Sea Board. We hope that this encourages players from remote areas in QLD to also affiliate and be covered by player insurance.
- 6. A monthly affiliation option is also available (at \$10 per month excl. GST)

Squash Queensland Board

On Sunday 2 August 2020 Colette Sultana and Squash Queensland President Jonathan James hosted the fourth monthly centre/regions conference call meeting. Jonathan provided an update on the requirements of centres and clubs to be Covid-19 compliant as many centres in the South East were visited by authorities recently to check they have correct procedures in place. If you are a centre owner or manager or on a committee putting procedures in place please ensure you have the correct information so you will be able to comply if you are requested to provide your records to authorities. You may be required to provide reports within an hour of the request.

Jonathan and Colette also gave an overview of the renaming proposal from "Q Squash" to "Squash Queensland". The rebranding project will also include a marketing strategy. If anyone has an idea for a Squash Queensland logo please contact Colette with your ideas.

There is also progress on making our affiliation more valuable with Squash Queensland forming partnerships with businesses who will provide benefits to Queensland members. If you are considering painting your squash walls or your house, please contact Colette as Dulux are providing players and clubs with 30% discount on premium lines of paint (applicable to house paint and court paint requests) when purchases are made through the Squash Queensland cash account. They have some other benefits in the pipeline for squash equipment, cleaning products and electricity. More information will be published soon.

Nominations will close on 14 August 2020. The 2019/2020 NR Champions will be awarded from this event. The 2019/2020 NR Best and Fairest will be awarded as will be the Kay Barclay Award at the presentation. There will not be a selection of Redbacks as there is no team event at the 2020 QJC.

2020/2021 Junior Tournament dates are:

Ingham 17/18 Oct 2020 Ingham Squash Centre
Cairns 13/14 Feb 2021 Cairns Squash Club
Townsville 6/7 Mar 2021 Wests Squash Club
Mackay 1/2 May 2021 Squash 52 Mackay

Please note Mackay and Cairns are the compulsory tournaments. To qualify for selection to the Redbacks team, juniors must play three (3) of the four (4) NR Junior tournaments. A junior must play both compulsory tournaments in Cairns and Mackay and at least 1 tournament in Ingham or Townsville. Juniors who meet this criteria will be given priority consideration when the Redbacks are selected regardless of strength of an individual who has not fully qualified or strength of the overall team. Please do not assume you will be selected to the Northern Redbacks if you have not qualified by attending the required tournaments or have not provided medical evidence to remain eligible.

Please note as the 2020 QJC is an individual event only, NR will not be arranging an accommodation camp and will not be sending coaches. Please make your own arrangements and contact me or a committee member if you have concerns.

2020 Q Open

Date: 25-27 September 2020 Venue: Daisy Hill Squash Centre Nominations are now open in SportyHQ. Nominations close: 18 September 2020

PLEASE BE AWARE IF INSTRUCTED, WE WILL NEED TO CANCEL ALL TOURNAMENTS IF DIRECTED TO DO SO BY THE QUEENSLAND OR AUSTRALIAN GOVERNMENTS DUE TO COVID-19.

2021 Queensland Junior Championships

The QJC to be held in Cairns in June/July 2021. The Queensland regions agreed the Squash Queensland administrator would be best placed to manage the QJC and the Q Squash Board also voted in favour. The functions the administrator will manage are the set up SportyHQ, setting the seedings according to the QLD seedings list, setting the draws, match scheduling and being at the championships to run the individual and team events.

Getting organised for the 2021 QJC is a very big job. We are currently designing the championship shirt and it will be made available on SportyHQ. We are also seeking sponsors. I'm wondering if there is anyone out there who is proficient with social media and would like to take charge of this for the QJC? Please think about how you can help and please contact me immediately with your ideas.

Queensland Junior Rankings

Since January 2020, the QLD Junior rankings have been updated by the Q Squash Administrator. So far this is working very well and reducing the burden on the NR to apply the actual ranking policy after junior tournaments. We have had no tournaments and therefore no updates to the rankings.

The State junior rankings and associated combined seedings will be relied upon by the Northern Region tournament hosts to set draws. Timely appeals will be essential. The appeal process in the policy provides for an internal review (like the old policy to give the rankers a chance to affirm or change their mind), and if the appellant remains aggrieved by that review decision, the appeal must be decided by an independent decision maker.

Affiliation with Q Squash

Affiliation is compulsory for all juniors to compete in the NR Junior tournaments and in the State and National Championships. Juniors must have full affiliation to play for the Northern Redbacks. Affiliation status will be checked prior to all 2020 season NR Junior tournaments and the Queensland Junior Championships.

Affiliation fees: \$73 for a full 1 year; or \$44 for seasonal (6 months).

Please remember affiliation comes with all sorts of benefits — especially personal insurance with participating in the game or related activity, such as fundraising.

Please note players living in Mackay, Townsville, Ingham and Cairns and all areas in between along the coast are not considered remote and do not qualify for the Remote Member Registration.

Due to the Covid-19 restrictions Queensland Squash has extended the 2020 affiliation periods.

Funding / Grants

NR have no current grant applications under consideration and no current grants underway. We are considering applying for the Queensland Community Gambling Fund. I am wondering about applying for first aid packs and supplies. It concerns me that when we hold a tournament we don't have first aid supplies and we can not even offer a band aid. If you have any ideas for a grant or would like to help make an application, please contact me ASAP.

Cairns Squash will again apply for a grant with the Cairns Regional Council for \$13 000 for the 2021 QJC.

Congratulations to Cairns Squash who have been successful to win a grant from the Queensland Gambling Community Fund for \$35 000 to purchase grandstands for the centre. The centre will also lodge a grant application to the Queensland Government Sport and Recreation for \$20,000 for IT equipment. Thanks to Cairns Squash members Shane and Trisha Stroud for coming on board to design and manufacture the grandstand and to Hemant Daya and Rhys Mountford-Jones who are volunteering their time to develop a plan for the IT project.

Help is required to identify suitable grants and applications to be written. There are many things that can be purchased with grant funding and this money can make a big difference to the NR. I'd like grant applications to run coaching clinics, purchase equipment and uniforms etc. However, if you have any ideas or you can help with identifying grants and writing applications please contact me.

Cash for Cans is a great fundraising idea for clubs.

Please consider getting a group together to fundraise for your club.

SportyHQ

Squash Australia (SA) has advised SA will cover subscription cost for affiliated clubs. Please do not pay for any SportyHQ subscriptions prior to discussing your clubs status and encourage all your club members to pay their affiliations to take advantage of this.

Squash Queensland have announced they are currently trialling Club Locker which is an internet based program that provides similar functions to SportyHQ. This trial is to understand which







No Card, No Start

New Blue Card laws are coming

From 31 August 2020, you will see changes to the blue card system. These changes include new laws that will apply to organisations, paid workers, business operators and volunteers.

These changes have been designed to strengthen and streamline the blue card system, and keep Queensland children safe. Under the **No Card, No Start** laws, people will need to hold a valid blue card before they start working with children.

People with paid applications submitted before 31 August 2020 will be able to continue working while their applications are being processed.

From 31 August 2020, to apply for a blue card you will need a customer reference cumber (CRN) and photo from the Department of Transport and Main Roads. A CRN is the number on your driver licence, photo identity card or proof-of-age card. TMR has a list of other documents where your CRN can be found.

We will work with TMR to verify your identity and obtain the photo to use on your blue card.

When the new laws start, you will be able to apply or renew your blue card online. This will mean a faster approval time for most applicants.

Under the **No Card**, **No Start** laws, people will need a valid blue card before they start work. The new laws will also allow people to apply for a blue card before they get a job. This means you can be job-ready!

Volunteers and students will need to be linked to an organisation before they submit their application to get a blue card for free. Speak to the person who looks after blue cards in your organisation about this.

Under the **No Card, No Start** laws, blue card holders will need to renew their card before it expires to continue working with children. You can renew your card up to 16 weeks before it expires.
