SQUASH QUEENSLAND BOARD

In light of the disruption Covid-19 has caused this year the Squash Queensland Board has decided to name a "for merit" Sharks Team. To be fair to all Queensland juniors the Board is allowing juniors who did not attend the QJC to submit an application and request an exemption to be eligible to be named in the Sharks team.

So if you would like to submit an application simply write an email to Colette Sultana and explain why you did not attend the 2020 QJC and request to be considered for the Sharks team.

Applications must be submitted to Colette by 5pm, Tuesday 13 Oct 2020.

The selection process will be as per policy, following the below criteria:

- 1) QJC results (no team results, will use Individual results)
- 2) Regional tournaments
- 3) QLD Junior Rankings
- 4) Exemptions

Please note Mackay and Cairns are the compulsory tournaments. To qualify for selection to the Redbacks team, juniors must play three (3) of the four (4) NR Junior tournaments. A junior must play both compulsory tournaments in Cairns and Mackay and at least 1 tournament in Ingham (TBC) or Townsville. Juniors who meet this criteria will be given priority consideration when the Redbacks are selected regardless of strength of an individual who has not fully qualified or strength of the overall team. Please do not assume you will be selected to the Northern Redbacks if you have not qualified by attending the required tournaments or have not provided medical evidence to remain eligible.

For 2021 Junior Season:

Compulsory tournaments (Mackay and Cairns) will be age and gender format. Non-Compulsory tournaments (Ingham (TBC) and Townsville) will be divisions.

2021 QUEENSLAND JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

The QJC to be held in Cairns in June/July 2021. The Queensland Squash Administrator will manage the QJC. The functions the administrator will manage are the set up of SportyHQ, setting the seedings according to the QLD seedings list, setting the draws, match scheduling and being at the championships to run the individual and team events.

Getting organised for the 2021 QJC is a very big job. Please think about how you can help and please contact me immediately with your ideas. In particular we are seeking sponsors and people to help with social media.

QUEENSLAND JUNIOR RANKINGS

Please note for the rankings following the 2020 QJC, provisions within the current policy were enacted due to low participation at the QJC due to concerns associated with Covid-19. This was to be fair to all the juniors and to maintain the ranking's validity.

Since January 2020, the QLD Junior rankings have been updated by the Squash Queensland Administrator. So far this is working very well and reducing the burden on the NR to apply the actual ranking policy after junior tournaments.

The State junior rankings and associated combined seedings will be relied upon by the NR tournament hosts to set draws. Timely appeals will be essential. The appeal process in the policy provides for an internal review (like the old policy to give the rankers a chance to affirm or change their mind), and if the appellant remains aggrieved by that review decision, the appeal must be decided by an independent decision maker.

AFFILIATION WITH Q SQUASH

Affiliation is compulsory for all juniors to compete in the NR Junior tournaments and in the State and National Championships. Juniors must have full affiliation to play for the Northern Redbacks. Affiliation status will be checked prior to all 2020 season NR Junior tournaments and the Queensland Junior Championships.

Affiliation fees: \$73 for a full 1 year; or \$44 for seasonal (6 months).

Please remember affiliation comes with all sorts of benefits — especially personal insurance with participating in the game or related activity, such as fundraising.

Please note players living in Mackay, Townsville, Ingham and Cairns and all areas in between

along the coast are not considered remote and do not qualify for the Remote Member Registration.

Due to the Covid-19 restrictions Squash Queensland has extended the 2020 affiliation periods.

FUNDING/GRANTS

Cairns currently has \$50,500 in grant money to spend and a possible further \$7000 on the way!

NR have 1 current grant applications under consideration. This is with the Australian Sports Foundation for \$5,400 to fund 2021 Redback Player's uniforms. If this application is successful this will save parents lots of money. I believe every Redback will need a new uniform in 2021.

Cairns Squash also has an application with the Australian Sports Foundation for \$7,000 to purchase training shirts for the juniors and new training equipment.

Congratulations to Cairns Squash who have been successful to win a grant from the Active Restart Infrastructure Recovery Fund work \$15,500. This funding is to put a monitor and ipad on all eight courts and 2 courts will be permanently set up to live stream. Cairns Squash is also in the process of reviewing grandstand designs. These grandstands are being funded by a grant worth \$35,000 from the Queensland Gambling Community Fund.

Cairns is also hosting a Bunnings Sausage Sizzle day on Sunday 11 Oct 2020. Good luck! Thanks to the Piccones Supa IGA for supporting with a whopping 20% discount.

Help is required to identify suitable grants and applications to be written. There are many things that can be purchased with grant funding and this money can make a big difference to the NR. I'd like grant applications to run coaching clinics, purchase equipment and uniforms etc. However, if you have any ideas or you can help with identifying grants and writing applications

SPORTY HQ

Squash Australia (SA) has advised SA will cover subscription cost for affiliated clubs. Please do not pay for any SportyHQ subscriptions prior to discussing your clubs status and encourage all your club members to pay their affiliations to take advantage of this.

Squash Queensland have announced they are currently trialling Club Locker which is an internet based program that provides similar functions to SportyHQ. This trial is to understand which system, Club Locker or SportyHQ is the more suited to everyone's needs.

for the 2020/2021 NR Junior Qualifiers:

Age event \$45 for one event or \$60 for 2 events Graded (Novice) \$15 per player Doubles \$10 per player

At each NR junior tournament a portion of the nomination fees is paid to the NR for the purpose of subsidising coaches to attend the QJC. \$10 and \$5 is collected for age and graded event players respectively.

IMPORTANT UPDATE from Q Squash: Player Affiliation Fees for 2020

Due to COVID-19 forced closures this year players have missed out on several weeks of their affiliation playing benefits and so the Board has decided to roll over this year's affiliations into next year. Whether you have already paid affiliation this year or have still to pay for it, the following changes apply:

- 1. The 2020 12 month player affiliation now expires on March 10th 2021, instead of the original 31st Dec 2020 expiry date.
- 2. The 2020 (Jan June) 6 month affiliation plan now expires on 10th Sep 2020, instead of the original 30th June 2020 expiry.
- 3. The second 6 months of the 2020 year (Jul Dec) will be due on 10th Sep 2020 and will expire on 10th March 2021.
- 4. Seasonal affiliation fees are still being discussed and will depend on the fixtures season in your region. More to come on that in the next few weeks.
- 5. We have introduced a remote player affiliation option, this is a discounted affiliation option for players who play at a location that is at least 300kms from the Eastern Sea Board. We hope that this encourages players from remote areas in QLD to also affiliate and be covered by player insurance.
- 6. A monthly affiliation option is also available (at \$10 per month excl. GST)

During September and early October 3 squash events lured NR Players south: the QJC, the Q Open and the Queensland Masters State Titles.



Marc Forster and Joanne Johnston were the only two NR players to be crowned **CHAMPIONS of the COURT!** Both won Master's titles: Marc O50 and Jo O45.

Five NR players reached finals and secured silver whilst three others had to settle for bronze.

The QJC were played at Sandgate. The Q Open at Daisy Hill and the QMSA State Titles were played in Toowoomba.

Michael Lawrence went close to winning the U13 Boys but found Southern's Flynn Bartlett too strong in the final eventually losing 6-11, 8-11, 10-12. Lawrence kept fighting but just fell short of pushing the match into a 4th game.





Mackay's Kayce Hoani-Vincent had to settle for second going down to Brisbane's Sarbani Maitra 5-11, 8-11, 4-11 in the Girls U15 final. Kayce then went on to play in the Q Open and finished runner up to Sarbani's brother Deeptangsu Maitra 6-11, 11-8, 6-11, 8-11 (24m) ... well done Kayce ... If you're talking to Kayce over the next few weeks just don't mention the name Maitra!





No Card, No Start

New Blue Card laws are coming

From 31 August 2020, you will see changes to the blue card system. These changes include new laws that will apply to organisations, paid workers, business operators and volunteers.

These changes have been designed to strengthen and streamline the blue card system, and keep Queensland children safe. Under the **No Card, No Start** laws, people will need to hold a valid blue card before they start working with children.

People with paid applications submitted before 31 August 2020 will be able to continue working while their applications are being processed.

From 31 August 2020, to apply for a blue card you will need a customer reference cumber (CRN) and photo from the Department of Transport and Main Roads. A CRN is the number on your driver licence, photo identity card or proof-of-age card. TMR has a list of other documents where your CRN can be found.

We will work with TMR to verify your identity and obtain the photo to use on your blue card.

When the new laws start, you will be able to apply or renew your blue card online. This will mean a faster approval time for most applicants.

Under the **No Card**, **No Start** laws, people will need a valid blue card before they start work. The new laws will also allow people to apply for a blue card before they get a job. This means you can be job-ready!

Volunteers and students will need to be linked to an organisation before they submit their application to get a blue card for free. Speak to the person who looks after blue cards in your organisation about this.

Under the **No Card, No Start** laws, blue card holders will need to renew their card before it expires to continue working with children. You can renew your card up to 16 weeks before it expires.
