I was happy to take on the challenge of writing a monthly newsletter and immediately, I could see the mast head I would start with.


Sadly, we lost Kay but I still feel connected to NR ... *it probably also helps that I was born in Cairns!*

Thank You

With the NR AGM this Saturday it is time for me to hang up my hat as the NR President. I started playing squash as a young child, as all my family played squash. I enjoyed the tournaments and I especially loved going to the Queensland Junior Championships. With Gavin, Corey and Amy all playing squash I thought it was time I contributed to this great sport that we all love. This is what brought me to consider a position on the NR Committee. Turns out I knew the game of squash really well but the going ons behind the scenes and what needs to be organised is something much different that I was not so sure about.

There is so much to think about when preparing for tournaments, considering seedings and rankings, tournament draws and scheduling. Preparing the NR Redbacks to go into camp for the QJC was a huge effort but so great once we were there. Thanks to all the parent helpers who made the QJC's so much fun and I'm sure we saved ourselves a small fortune because we worked together.

The NR committee have worked on the by-laws, grants and funding and I have built my knowledge about what is happening in the state and around Australia as what is going on in other areas in many ways impacts the NR. It is an understatement to say I've had a huge learning curve.

I can instantly think of 3 things I'm most proud of since being Vice President and President of the NR. Firstly, is the NR transition of the junior tournaments. This was started by Dean Morzone and I. We introduced sponsorship packages and now participating centres produce junior tournaments that have a professional touch with sponsors and valuable monetary prizes. I believe for our region to continue to grow, we need to come up with even more innovation that draws in new players and makes squash competitive against all the other sports.

The second issue I think has been really important for NR and all of Queensland squash is the building of the relationships between our 4 Queensland regions and the Squash Queensland Board. There has certainly been a concerted effort to mend relationships and remove barriers that have fragmented the squash community.

The third highlight I instantly recall but I left it to last, is the NR Redbacks being the Queensland State Champions in 2018 and 2019. I recall ordering our cake and agonising over putting "Champions" in writing on top. Brisbane had been the "Champions" for the previous 14 years but I thought win or lose our NR kids are "Champions". Now the NR Redbacks are the defending Champions as we move towards hosting the QJC in June/July 2021. I'll certainly be there to

SQ are now enforcing for all Squash Queensland sanctioned tournaments, \$5/participant must be paid to SQ. The NR Junior tournaments must all be SQ and Squash Australia sanctioned tournaments to be approved ranking events. These funds will be used specifically to develop

junior squash in Queensland. The NR committee has decided this fee will need to be added to the tournament nomination fee as the current nomination fee could not absorb this new fee. This can be further discussed at the NR AGM in February.

SQ are continuing to add to the value of affiliation. Currently, Colette is asking for anyone wanting to purchase Dunlop balls to get in touch with her to do a large group order through SQ. Mackay 52 and Cairns Squash were both successful to win grants from SQ to provide squash programs for 8-12 year olds (new players and beginners). Each grant is for \$625. The goal of these grants are to help grow the sport of squash and recruit some new young players.

Please note Mackay and Cairns are the compulsory tournaments. To qualify for selection to the Redbacks team, juniors must play three (3) of the four (4) NR Junior tournaments. A junior must play both compulsory tournaments in Cairns and Mackay and at least 1 tournament in Ingham (TBC) or Townsville. Juniors who meet this criteria will be given priority consideration when the Redbacks are selected regardless of strength of an individual who has not fully qualified or strength of the overall team. Please do not assume you will be selected to the Northern Redbacks if you have not qualified by attending the required tournaments or have not provided medical evidence to remain eligible.

2021 Queensland Junior Championships

The QJC to be held in Cairns in June/July 2021. The SQ Administrator will manage the QJC. The functions the administrator will manage are the setup of SportyHQ, setting the seedings according to the Queensland seedings list, setting the draws, match scheduling and being at the championships to run the individual and team events.

SQ, NR and Cairns Squash are coordinating to make this event successful and memorable. There is lots to be done and we welcome everyone to get involved. Contact me if you have any ideas or you can offer your time to help. In particular we are seeking sponsors and people to help with social media.

Queensland Junior Rankings

Since January 2020, the Queensland Junior rankings have been updated by the SQ Administrator. So far this is working very well and reducing the burden on the NR to apply the actual ranking policy after junior tournaments. Also provides consistency across the regions.

1 February 2021 Queensland Junior rankings are available on the SQ Webpage.

The State junior rankings and associated combined seedings will be relied upon by the NR tournament hosts to set draws. Timely appeals will be essential. The appeal process in the policy provides for an internal review (like the old policy to give the rankers a chance to affirm or change their mind), and if the appellant remains aggrieved by that review decision, the appeal must be decided by an independent decision maker.

Affiliation with Squash Queensland (SQ)

If you were not affiliated in 2020, now is the time to affiliate for 2021. If you were affiliated in 2020, your affiliation is good until March as SQ have extended the affiliation period due to Covid shutdowns in 2020.

Affiliation is compulsory for all juniors to compete in the NR Junior tournaments and in the State and National Championships. Juniors must have full affiliation to play for the Northern Redbacks. Affiliation status will be checked prior to all 2021 season NR Junior tournaments and the Queensland Junior Championships.

Affiliation fees: \$73 for a full 1 year; or \$44 for seasonal (6 months).

Please remember affiliation comes with all sorts of benefits – especially personal insurance with participating in the game or related activity, such as fundraising.

Please note players living in Mackay, Townsville, Ingham and Cairns and all areas in between along the coast are not considered remote and do not qualify for the Remote Member Registration.

Due to the Covid-19 restrictions QS has extended the 2020 affiliation periods.

Northern Region Meeting

The next NR meeting will be at the 2021 Smithfield Dental Cairns Junior Championships in February 2021. This will also be the AGM.

Funding/Grants

Cairns Squash are so close to completing the redesign of Sportsworld. We have 6 new grandstands, a tv on every court to display scores and also to promote our sponsors and 2 live streaming courts. This funding came from grants from the Active Restart Infrastructure Recovery Fund worth \$15,500 and a grant worth \$35,000 from the Queensland Gambling Community Fund. I'm looking forward to you all seeing and using this equipment this weekend at the 2021 Smithfield Dental Cairns Junior Championships.

Cairns Squash successfully gained funds from the Covid-19 grants to support clubs to get back on the court. Cairns used some of these funds to subsidise the new Club shirts. These shirts are now being distributed and as they were only \$15 for kids and \$30 for adults we got our best ever number of shirt orders.

Grant money is really free money available to all clubs if you are willing to spend some time seeking suitable grants and completing the applications. Organisation applications vary in complexity. However, most applications are relatively simple and do not take too much time to complete. All centres should be applying for grants. Nomination fees

for the 2021 NR Junior Qualifiers

Age event \$50 for one event
or \$65 for 2 events
Graded (Novice) \$20 per player
Doubles \$10 per player

At each NR junior tournament a portion of the nomination fees is paid to the NR for the purpose of subsidising coaches to attend the QJC:

**\$10 (Age) and \$5 (Graded)
is collected from each player.**

From 1/1/21 all NR Junior Qualifiers must now be sanctioned by **Squash Queensland**. Accordingly a \$5 Fee is collected and paid to Squash Queensland.

Sparty HQ

Squash Australia (SA) has advised SA will cover subscription cost for affiliated clubs. Please do not pay for any Sparty HQ subscriptions prior to discussing your clubs status and encourage all your club members to pay their affiliations to take advantage of this.

Squash Queensland have announced they are currently trialing Club Locker which is an internet based program that provides similar functions to Sparty HQ. This trial is to understand which system, Club Locker or Sparty HQ is the more suited to everyone's needs.

- Be a signatory at the bank.

VICE PRESIDENT'S ROLE:

- Be available to NR Members, parents, coaches, club committee member and court owners.
- Work with Clubs to arrange and manage the NR junior tournaments.
- Advise SQ and Squash Australia of the NR junior tournament dates.
- Consider gaps and barriers to participation and introduce new ideas support promotion and growth of squash.
- Work with Squash Media to promote the NR junior tournaments.
- Support clubs to use SportyHQ and liaise with SportyHQ developers as required.
- Follow up and write grant applications and drive fundraising opportunities.

- Advise the President of any financial concerns.
- Reconcile accounts as invoices are paid.
- Pay bills.
- Manage the bank accounts.
- Prepare accounts for the auditor.
- Ensure appropriate spending of grant funding and sponsorship money, maintain appropriate receipts and complete the acquittal process.
- Be a signatory at the bank.

NR SELECTOR'S ROLE:

3 Positions

- Must be available to travel to the NR junior tournaments.
- Must have an interest to track progression of juniors for consideration of selection to the Northern Redbacks.
- Must be available for discussion with other selectors and the NR Committee about the Northern Redback's team selection and team captains.
- Be aware of the ranking policy and NR junior's rankings.
- Must avoid favouritism for own players and children when selecting the Northern Redback's representatives. Selection must be based on merit/performance.

Note: NR selectors will no longer be required to update the Junior rankings.

During her visit to Mackay Channel 7 interviewed her which resulted in another important exposure for squash on TV.



2020-21 State Affiliation

IMPORTANT UPDATE from Squash Queensland: Player Affiliation Fees for 2020/21

Due to COVID-19 forced closures this year players have missed out on several weeks of their affiliation playing benefits and so the Board has decided to roll over this year's affiliations into next year. Whether you have already paid affiliation this year or have still to pay for it, the following changes apply:



1. The 2020 12 month player affiliation now expires on March 10th 2021, instead of the original 31st Dec 2020 expiry date.
2. The 2020 (Jan - June) 6 month affiliation plan now expires on 10th Sep 2020, instead of the original 30th June 2020 expiry.
3. The second 6 months of the 2020 year (Jul - Dec) will be due on 10th Sep 2020 and will expire on 10th March 2021.
4. Seasonal affiliation fees are still being discussed and will depend on the fixtures season in your region. More to come on that in the next few weeks.
5. We have introduced a remote player affiliation option, this is a discounted affiliation option for players who play at a location that is at least 300kms from the Eastern Sea Board. We hope that this encourages players from remote areas in QLD to also affiliate and be covered by player insurance.
6. A monthly affiliation option is also available (at \$10 per month excl. GST)
