

"Etiquette"

On and Off the Court

This month we drift away from the actual rules of the game and look at Squash Etiquette on and off the court.

The following are general guidelines for etiquette On and Off the court.

For Players:

Neat and tidy clothing.

Juniors must wear glasses at all times whilst on the court.

Take your turn to mark and referee a match.

Be ready to play your match when called.

Players must be on court within ten minutes of the previous match having been completed. Ideally, players should be ready to go on court immediately after the previous match has been completed.

Be on time to arrive at the centre for your scheduled match time. Tournament rules generally require players to check in at least 15 minutes before scheduled match time. Pennant By-laws require players to be present 10 minutes before the advertised starting time of the fixture.

Acknowledge your opponent's good shots.

Own up to your "Not-ups" and "Downs".

Retrieve the ball for the server.

Don't smash the ball around the court between rallies.

Never argue with the referee.

Control your temper.

Shake hands at end of your match and acknowledge the marker and referee.

Usually, the winner offers to buy the loser a drink.

For Spectators:

Be a good sport when watching – applaud other teams' good shots as well. Do not call out during a rally.

Cheer your players.

Generally:

Never comment on anyone's gender, race, religion or ability.

Do not use your mobile phone unless using it for keeping score!

A survey some time ago found that people left the sport not because of late nights and travelling but because they did not like getting abused when marking or refereeing. They came to enjoy the competition and social interaction afterwards.

When playing and not liking a decision made by the referee or marker, before speaking, think how you would like to be treated if it was you upstairs refereeing or marking the game. This does not mean you cannot question a decision but how you go about it.





At the AGM in November we talked about becoming a club and being incorporated. This has happened and we have applied to WA Squash to be affiliated as a club. This will be the first new club in the metro area since Victoria Park about 15 years ago.
