# NEWS BEEL

### **AUSSIE NEWS: SEPTEMBER 2016**

- NSW's Tamika Saxby will join Rachael Grinham, Christine Nunn and Donna Urquhart in the Australian Team to contest the World Team Championships in Paris in November.
- Cameron Pilley scored a strong win against World #3 Omar Mosaad (EGY) in the M100 China Open winning his first round match 3-0: 11-4, 11-5, 11-7 (55m) but was knocked out in the quarter final by #8 seed Borja Golan (ESP) 11-8, 6-11, 11-8, 11-4 (69m).
- Zac Alexander and Tamika Saxby won their 5th PSA Title for the year when they won their respective events at the North Coast Open. Seeded #2 Alexander beat #1 seed Josh Larkin 13-11, 11-4, 11-2 whilst #2 seed Saxby beat #1 seed Lisa Camilleri 11-4, 11-8, 11-3.
- Samantha Calvert, Robert Palmer, Dominique Ratcliffe and Rohan Toole represented Australia at the World University Championships in Malaysia. Palmer was eliminated in Round 1 whilst the other 3 Australians exited in Round 2. Calvert finished 11th, Palmer 41st, Ratcliffe 23rd and Toole 21st.
- The Australian World University team finished 8th overall in the Teams event. 7th place play-off: [7] SWITZERLAND bt [9] AUSTRALIA 2/1 Robin Gadola bt Rohan Toole 11-13, 11-4, 9-11, 11-8, 11-7 (62m) Milena Penkov lost to Samantha Calvert 12-14, 5-11, 8-11 (27m) Remo Handl bt Dominique Ratcliffe 11-5, 11-2, 11-4 (23m)
- The WSF announced that 951 players will be participating in the World Masters Championships in South Africa. Sarah Fitz-Gerald is the #1 seed in WO45 whilst Brian Cook is the #1 seed in the MO65.
- Ryan Cuskelly was seeded #1 but had to settle for the runner up prize in the M25 Charlottesville Open to [2] Stephen Coppinger (RSA) 8-11, 13-15, 14-12, 11-9, 11-4 (90m)

Rex Hedrick and Donna Urquhart had no luck at the Macau Open. Hedrick met a very handy #1 seed in the first round. Marwan Elshorbagy (EGY) won the match 6-11, 12-10, 11-6, 11-7 (58m) whilst #6 seed Urquhart was beaten narrowly by [4] Emily Whitlock (ENG) 11-9, 11-8, 11-9 (34m).

Sarah Cardwell reached the final of the W10 China Squash Challenge Cup but had to settle for 2nd place. #1 seed Tong Tsz-Wing (HKG) won the event 3-1: 11-7, 4-11, 11-5, 11-5.

### **AUSSIE NEWS: SEPTEMBER 2016**

- The Al-Ahram International was played in front of the Pyramids of Giza. Rachael Grinham qualified for the main event but was bundled out in the 1st round by #1 seed and World Champion Nour El Sherbini (EGY) 11-7, 11-4, 11-4 (23m). Cameron Pilley also met the #1 seed in the 1st round losing a close match 11-9, 7-11, 9-11, 8-11 (60m) against Mohamed Elshorbagy (EGY).
- Despite being #1 seed for the W10 Nash Cup in Ontario Canada, Christine Nunn was beaten in the semi-finals by #3 seed Misaki Kobayashi (JPN). Kobayashi won 6-11, 11-7, 11-4, 11-3 (32m).
- The Australian Junior Championships got underway at Thornleigh Squash Centre in Sydney.
- Queensland's Alex Eustace defended his U19 title he won in Cairns last year with a 3-0 victory over Alex Oswald 11-6, 11-9, 13-11 from South Australia. Victoria's Jessica Graham outlasted South Australia's Lauren Aspinall to win the Girls U19 title 6-11, 13-11, 3-11, 11-8, 11-3. Other National Champions included:

- Ryan Cuskelly and Cameron Pilley were quarter-final casualties at the M100 Netsuite Open in San Francisco. [1] Gregory Gaultier (FRA) beat #8 seed Cuskelly 11-6, 11-9, 11-6 (47m) whilst [4] Marwan Elshorbagy (EGY) beat #7 seed Pilley 11-2, 7-11, 11-5, 11-5 (66m).

The Australian Junior Teams Championship got underway at Thornleigh with Queensland the strong favourites to win their 13th successive overall team championship. The SHARKS will be up against the WASPS from WA on the last day after the West Aussies finished second last year.


