10th REDtone KL Junior Open

648 players participated in the 2016 REDtone KL Junior Open.

Queensland was represented by **Nick Calvert**, **Lachlan Coxsedg**e and **Taylor Jones**.

Lachlan Coxsedg was seeded 5/8 in the U19 Boys. Coxsedg reached the Quarter Finals but after a promising opening game was no match for the #1 seed going down in straight. He then blew a 2 games to 1 lead in his opening 5-8 Playoff match.

Nick Calvert also reached the Quarters of the U19 Boys but was outclassed in straight by a 3/4 seed. Calvert played strongly in his next two match ups beating two 5/8 seeds on his way to finishing 5th.

Seeded 9/16 Calvert was the only Australian to perform better than their initial seeding.

Taylor Jones also reached the Quarters and like Coxsedg had to play the #1 seed. Jones lost in straight but regrouped to win her next two match ups. Jones was unlucky in her final match - the playoff for 9th - where she lost in four but the scores were very tight.

National junior coaches Vicki Cardwell and Tim Cowell helped manage and coach the squad of 11 players. There were six from WA, 3 from Queensland and 1 each from Tasmania and NSW.

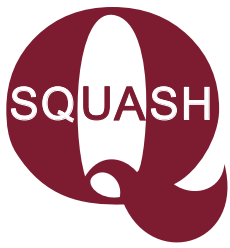

AFFILIATION

A message from Q Squash President - Ros Preston

Following the AGM of Squash Australia in November and the recent Q Squash Board meeting the following affiliation categories have been set for 2017.

1. Full Registration \$66.00 per annum - Q Squash fee payable up front. This covers you for all organised squash competitions and tournaments and includes Player Accident Insurance and access to Matrix. Some regions may charge an additional fee to this so you need to talk to your regional committee or your centre operator for the actual price payable in your region.

2. Seasonal Registration \$40.00 - Q Squash fee payable up front at beginning of each season - 2 seasons per year. This covers you for all organised squash competitions and tournaments and includes Player Accident Insurance and access to Matrix.

3. Social Registration \$33.00 - Q Squash fee payable up front. This covers **social hire** players and competition **fill in** players with Player Accident Insurance. Social Registration covers a **fill in** player for up to 3 matches. From their 4th match a **fill in** player will be required to upgrade to full registration. This is also the category for **social playing parents** who wish to be covered for Player Accident Insurance.

4. Affiliate Registration \$10.00 per annum. Typically for parents of players or persons wanting to be a friend of "Squash".

Affiliations fall due on 1st January and expire on 31st December of each year for full playing/paying players ... remember if your season goes over into the new year you will need to renew to remain covered for player accident insurance.

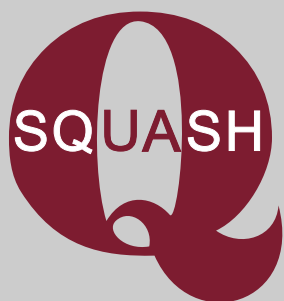
Being affiliated to your State and National bodies helps both organisations to obtain funding from Government. Funding is heavily based on the numbers of registered players a sport has. The more players we have registered the more money we should be able to access to grow the grassroots and HP levels of our wonderful sport.

All players affiliating have access to the Q Squash Newsletter and also the Squash Australia members portal where you can obtain great discounts off everyday purchases.

By being an affiliated player in Queensland you are helping to fund the Q Open, Mackay Open, Cairns International, Sandgate Women's Open, Brisbane Open, Scottvale Park Open, Gladstone Open and Moura Open throughout 2017. As well as these events Q Squash is able to help support our Junior Sharks to attend both the Australian Junior Championships and the Australian Junior Open.

Without the support of our players we would not be able to do any of these things. Please be proactive in spreading the word to help us grow our numbers in 2017.

With the guidance from a well qualified and knowledgeable coaching team: **Riley and Elisha Steffen**, the junior squash players from Gladstone, Rockhampton and Boyne Valley were in very good hands.

Riley has Fitness, Squash and Strength and Conditioning training whilst Elisha is an Exercise Sport Scientist and an Exercise Physiologist (specialising in athlete development),

Two full days were focused on developing each players athletic abilities, fitness and squash skills.

Players maximised their time at the Centre by doing:

- ♦ strength and conditioning exercises to enhance performance;
- ♦ learning how to move like an elite athlete including warm ups and appropriate recovery to avoid injury;
- ♦ individual health assessments to

explore imbalances that they can then improve upon;

- ♦ how to enhance their squash skills, game play and routines;
- ♦ as well as gaining their Club Refereeing certificates.

The coaches believe that these junior players have the ability to be strong competitors, particularly now that they have the robust basis and foundation to be professional athletes.

The Scottvale Camp was extremely beneficial for all involved.

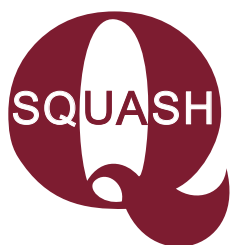

Robyn Prentice will inject her brand of coaching and enthusiasm for the game into developing Southern Region juniors in 2017.

Prentice has been a professional coach since 1984, when in fact she started out developing players in Southern Region!. From there she was appointed Head Squash Pro at the Royal Glenora Club in Canada from 1989 to 1999.

Prentice has excelled as a player and as a coach. As a player she represented Queensland from 1971 to 1988. She was the Toowoomba Open Champion from 1972 to 1988. She has been a World Masters Champion: 40+, 60+ and Runner Up: 45+. In 2013 Prentice was the Australian 65+ Champ!

In recent years Prentice has coached Solayman Nowrozi with great success. Nowrozi achieved a #1 National ranking for his age group. He is now focusing on the PSA World Tour but will join Robyn to assist with the development of the SR juniors.

“My goal is to assist SR with the promotion of junior squash in the region. In other words, action my proposal to develop new juniors as well as work with the existing juniors in the Region” said Prentice.
