

10th REDtone KL Junior Open

648 players participated in the 2016 REDtone KL Junior Open.

The most popular event was the Boys U13 where 98 competitors lined up to compete for the title. Australia was represented by Oscar Curtis (WA) who was a finalist in the same age group at the AJC. He was beaten in the 2nd Round but managed to finish 20th overall.

AJC U13 Champion Gregory Chan (WA) had to step up to a higher age group and finished a credible 7th from a field of 85 competitors. Chan was the only Aussie to reach a quarter final.

11 athletes represented Australia. Six from WA, 3 from Queensland and 1 each from Tasmania and NSW.

National junior coaches Vicki Cardwell and our very own Tim Cowell helped manage and coach the squad.

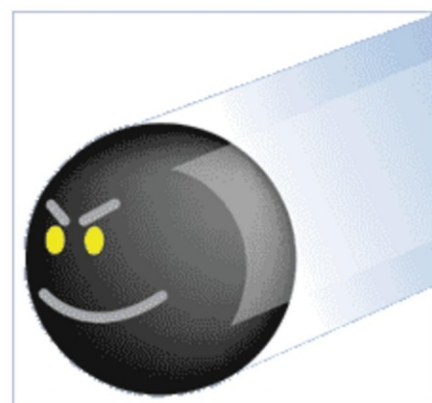

Masters of Squash

CHAS RENNER



Chas Renner is an icon of WA Masters Squash and a life member of WA Squash since 2003.

Chas began playing squash in his 30's, early in the 1960's. He played at Melville Squash until it closed then moved to Hilton where he is now a life member.

In the early years Chas became involved in coaching, completing the Level One course in the early 1990's. He was a founding member

of the WA branch of the PSCAA (Professional Squash Coaches Association of Australia).

Chas's involvement in coaching included coaching the juniors at Hilton squash for many years. He developed an interest amongst these young people, who are now the future of Masters squash. Along with his partner Joyce Barnett, Chas had a vision to develop and promote the game amongst young players, and a large number of WA State senior representative players are testament to their dedication, guidance and encouragement in the formative years of those players.

Chas and Joyce were involved in the WA Junior State Squads and development groups and were sometime Managers of the State junior teams, travelling interstate and overseas, which thus prevented him from entering the AMSA Championships over a number of years. However, he has still managed to participate 21 times, receiving his 20 year medallion in 2015. Chas is Australian Masters Champion in his age group 7 times. Winning once in the over 75's, 3 times in the over 80's and 3 times in the over 85's.

Chas was introduced to Masters Squash in the 80's through the Masters Friday night competition, at Canning Bridge Squash centre, where he met Joyce Barnett. He has

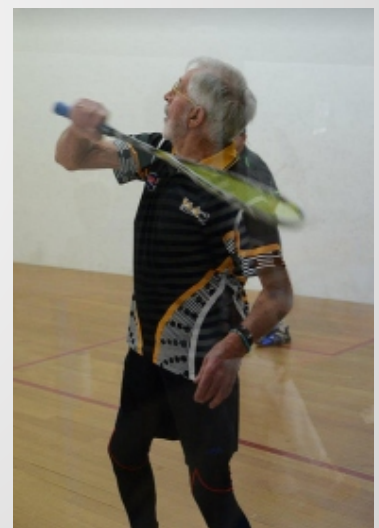

continued to play and support this competition until this day. He has been a member of the WA Masters Squash committee over the years and although not officially on the current committee, Chas volunteers his invaluable support in the background.

Chas have been an active player and supporter of WA Masters Squash since the early 80's. He has officially retired and doesn't play much any more. He just makes regular come backs to train for and compete in the Australian Masters Championships. He continues to participate and support WA Masters Squash Committee volunteering his time at tournaments and other events.

Chas is an integral part of Masters in WA, he is the current Over 85 AMSA champion, is a Life Member of WA Squash and truly, a Master of Squash.

Regional Schools Championships 2016

Tim Cowell, Tim Cornish and myself visited a number of regions to finish another successful year promoting our wonderful game via the "**Squash Inflatable Program**".

The team delivered to over 60 schools either in the school yard or at squash courts to well over 9,000 kids in both the regional and metropolitan areas.

The grand finale for the years participation programs is our School Championships which we deliver to various areas around the State. We hosted 4 championships this year which involved a dozen schools:

Kojonup (Southern Region) - Champion School: St Bernards Catholic Primary School (40 Year 6 participants)

Katanning (Great Southern Region) - Champion School: Braeside Primary School (60 Year 6 participants)

Esperance (Goldfields Region) - Champion School: Esperance Primary School (60 Year 6 participants)

Calingiri (Midlands region) - Champion School: Yerecoin Primary School (40 Year 4/5/6 participants)

Schools compete against each other utilising various formats (decided by courts, time, number of participants and the level of play) and the coaches and teachers facilitate the day.

The key objectives of the event are to make sure everyone is engaged, having fun competing and allowing them to experience the game under tournament conditions that hopefully will lead them to the local junior club/competition.

It certainly excites the youngsters to think about taking up the game and we feel that it is a perfect way to end the year especially on such a positive note. Responses from the teachers is always positive and they really enjoy the competitive spirit.

WA Squash would ideally like to expand the Schools Championships regionally and are committed exploring ways for this to happen.

Its fantastic to see that the sport here in WA has an ongoing commitment to exposing our game to all walks of life and our development plan is a testament to the way our juniors have been performing over a number of years now at the National level.

None of these programs could get off the ground with out the on going support of the Department of Sport and Recreation, Healthways and all the volunteers that make these types of events a success. **We look forward to doing it all again in 2017.**
